January	<p>Student Achievement and School Support (SASS) Division will provide mid-term report to the Board on progress towards meeting District Goals and Objectives.</p> <p>Board and Superintendent will review and update Goals and Objectives for the upcoming year that will drive the Local Educational Agency (LEA) Plan and the Single Plans for Student Achievement (SPSA.)</p>	
February & March	<p>A draft of the District's Goals and Objectives will be shared with all administrators, the Parent Advisory Committee (PAC), District English Advisory Committee (DELAC), and the Community Advisory Committee (CAC) for input.</p> <p>A Board study session may be scheduled to discuss the input gathered from the various committees, departments, and school sites.</p> <p>The Board will adopt the updated Goals and Objectives for the upcoming school year.</p>	Principals will share the draft of the Goals and Objectives with School Site Council and English Language Advisory Councils (ELAC) for feedback.
April & May	Based on the new Goals and Objectives, the SASS Division will develop a staff development calendar for the summer and the upcoming school year.	Principals will facilitate the completion of the Academic Program Survey (APS) to include summer and fall staff development needs.
June & July	The SASS Division will provide summer staff development opportunities.	Principals will share staff development opportunities with staff.
August & September	<p>District staff will review and begin to revise the LEA Plan.</p> <p>SASS Division will present STAR, API, and AYP data as well as other measurable target data to the Board. (September presentation – elementary)</p>	Principal will review STAR data with staff and parent groups and set measurable student achievement targets for SPSA.
October & November	<p>SASS Division will present STAR, API, and AYP data as well as other measurable target data to the Board. (October presentation– middle school, November presentation – high school)</p> <p>SASS Division will provide SPSA development workshops.</p>	Principals will facilitate the revision of their SPSA and present to School Site Council for approval.
December	LEA Plan and SPSAs will be submitted to the Board for approval.
