



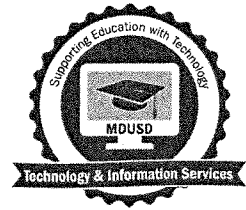

Chromebook Deployment Information

The Chromebooks rely heavily on a robust wireless network to function correctly. We ask that schools check with their techs prior to ordering any Chromebooks in order to make sure this is a good fit for your school site and that there is appropriate coverage where the devices are going to be used. This list below describes the limited support of Chromebook computers provided by TIS personnel. Technical information about Google Apps For Education (GAPE) can be found here: <http://bit.ly/1mOKd44>

The setup and configuration of the Google accounts will be the responsibility of the site. TIS recommends that each school have at least a couple of Google certified teachers that are comfortable with supporting the Chromebook/Google management system for their students. The School Support department (See contact information below) can provide some direction on where to find training.

Chromebooks require a little up front planning prior to purchasing, as the devices are tied to a domain that the teachers will use with their students. Vendors will require the Google domain setup information in order to place the order (see requirements below). Adam Welcome, in the School Support Department, has set up a domain for schools to use that have not created one on their own (mdusd.net).

TIS personnel can help connecting Chromebooks to the wireless network. In the event where a Chromebook ceases to function, TIS personnel will do their best to evaluate hardware failures, and determine if it is covered by the warranty. Most of Chromebooks for sale on our website do not offer the same warranty or durability as the more expensive, business-class computers that may be found elsewhere on the TIS purchasing website. Any physical damage to the computer, whether intentional, accidental, or environmental, will be considered misuse of the product and will not be covered by the warranty.

Student and employee information considered private per education code and FERPA will not be stored using a Chromebook. Examples of confidential information include, but are not limited to, grades, medical information, employee evaluations, etc.
