




## English Learners in Mt. Diablo

#### **Ever-ELs**








## English Language Proficiency Assessments for California (ELPAC)

- New assessment- replaces CELDT
- Initial ELPAC- within 30 days of enrollment
- Summative ELPAC- spring Feb through May
- Assesses speaking, listening, reading, and writing




## **ELPAC Performance Levels - Summative Test**

ELPAC Level	ELPAC Gauge	What Students Can Typically Do at Each Level	
		Students at this level have well developed English skills.	
LEVEL 4		<ul> <li>They can usually use English to learn new things in school and to interact in social situations.</li> </ul>	
		<ul> <li>They may occasionally need help using English.</li> </ul>	
		Students at this level have moderately developed English skills.	
LEVEL 3		<ul> <li>They can sometimes use English to learn new things in school and to interact in social situations.</li> </ul>	
		<ul> <li>They may need help using English to communicate on less-familiar school topics and in less-familiar social situations.</li> </ul>	
		Students at this level have <b>somewhat developed</b> English skills.	
LEVEL 2		<ul> <li>They usually need help using English to learn new things at school and to interact in social situations.</li> </ul>	
		<ul> <li>They can often use English for simple communication.</li> </ul>	
LEVEL 1		Students at this level are at a <b>beginning stage</b> of developing English skills.	
		<ul> <li>They usually need substantial help using English to learn new things at school and to interact in social situations.</li> </ul>	
		<ul> <li>They may know some English words and phrases.</li> </ul>
