
# 2010 Measure C Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee Annual Report to the Board of Education For FY July 1, 2014 to June 30, 2015



#### Expenditures


- Program has encumbered \$271.25 million in contracts and administration costs as well as \$3.02 million in change orders.
- \$267.10 million has been expended on construction and design services.

#### Solar

- All sites are completed and have received DSA letter "Closed with Certification".
- Expected electric generation of 45 Kw/day or 12.1mw/year.
- Savings on track to reach \$3 million a year.



## HVAC

- Board requested completion of HVAC projects by 2014. Projects rescheduled into three phases instead of four.
- 14 of 15 projects "Closed with Certification"
  - DSA certification for Valhalla anticipated by 2015/2016.

## Technology

- Infrastructure Phase
  - MEP, switches and other infrastructure items completed at secondary schools with DSA certification 2013.
- Modernization (Classroom Enhancement)
  - Phase I completed (test ready).
  - Phase II in progress
    - \$185 per/student
    - Pending bond sale

## Modernization

- Modernization broken down into several phases – Security, Portable Replacement and Middle School General Science and Modernization, High School Enhancements.
- Middle School Science Classrooms
  - Complete
  - ALL DSA certified
- Portable replacements
  - Complete





#### Modernization

- Security intrusion system replacement
  - Complete and operational
- High School Enhancement II projects were approved at Board meetings between August and October 2012. Some Enhancement I and II projects are at DSA for approval and are currently in the proposal phase.
