# Intradistrict Transfer Request Period



## Grades 1-12

- October 17, 2016 – January 17, 2017

## Grade K

- February 7, 2017 – March 1, 2017

# Procedures

**Intradistrict Transfers are for students who reside inside the MDUSD boundaries requesting to transfer to another MDUSD School.**

## **Applications submitted to Student Services:**

- October 17, 2016 – January 17, 2017 – Grades 1-12
- February 7, 2017 – March 1, 2017 – **Incoming Kindergarteners**

## **Lottery:**

- February 13, 2017 – Grades 6-12
- April 13, 2017 – Grades K-5

## **Notification:**

- By April 30, 2017 – Grades 6-12
- By June 30, 2017 – Grades K – 5

## **Appeal:**

- By May 1-12 – Grades 6-12
- By July 10-31 – Grades K – 5

# Intradistrict Transfers

## Types of Transfers

- **School Choice (K-12)**
- Applications are accepted for students who reside in MDUSD and want to attend another MDUSD school
  
- **Open Enrollment Act SBX5 4 (1-12)**
- Applications are accepted for students whose residence school for 2017-2018 would be:
  - Fair Oaks Elementary, Sun Terrace Elementary, El Dorado Middle, Oak Grove Middle, Riverview Middle and Ygnacio Valley High
  - Can Select ANY MDUSD school with a higher API score
  
- **School Option (9-12)**
- Applications are accepted for students who live within MDUSD boundaries, and are not assigned to a specific High School attendance area
  
- **Two-Way Dual Immersion (TWDI) (K-2)**
- Applications are accepted for students who want to participate in TWDI, at Bancroft Elementary, to develop bi-literacy in English and Spanish, master grade level core standards, and develop cultural proficiency

# Interdistrict Transfers

- Request Period Begins February 14, 2017

## Students who reside within MDUSD boundaries and are requesting a RELEASE from MDUSD

- **Types of Transfers :**

- School Choice – Grades K – 12
  - Applications are accepted for students who reside within MDUSD boundaries and want to attend a school in another District
- Child Care – Grades K – 8
  - Applications are accepted for students who reside within MDUSD boundaries and have verified Child Care in another District's boundaries
- Employment – Grades K – 12
  - Applications are accepted for students who reside within MDUSD boundaries and parent/guardian have verified employment in another District's boundaries
- Open Enrollment Act – Grades K – 12
  - Applications are accepted for students who reside within MDUSD boundaries of the designated schools and want to attend a school in another District with a higher API score

# Interdistrict Transfers – cont'd

- Request Period Begins February 14, 2017

## Students that reside outside MDUSD boundaries but want to attend a MDUSD school

- **Types of Transfers**

- School Choice – Grades K – 12
  - Applications are accepted for students who reside outside of MDUSD boundaries and want to attend a MDUSD school
- Child Care – Grades K – 8
  - Applications are accepted for students who reside outside of MDUSD boundaries and have verified Child Care within MDUSD boundaries and want to attend a MDUSD school
- Employment – Grades K – 12
  - Applications are accepted for students who reside outside of MDUSD boundaries and parent/guardian have verified employment within MDUSD boundaries and want to attend a MDUSD school
- Open Enrollment Act – Grades K – 12
  - Applications are accepted for students who reside outside of MDUSD boundaries and want to attend a MDUSD school with a higher API score other than their school/district of residence
