
Equitable Access to Technology for Students and Staff

- Devices:
 - We issued 17,000 Chromebooks to students during the 2020/2021 school year



- Systemic Use of Google Classroom (Grades 3-12) and Seesaw (Grades TK-2)
- Increased Use of Online Resources
- Home Access:
 - 1,600 Hotspots Issued to Families



Continuing Equitable Access for Students

- 1:1 is an **Equity Initiative**, not a Technology Initiative
 - Curriculum, Resources, Materials

- 1:1 Program
 - A whole school in which every student and teacher is issued a
 device for their use 24/7 throughout the school year
- 1:1 Ratio
 - A school that has achieved a ratio of at least one chromebook for every student

- Teacher Laptops Prioritize 1:1 Programs
