PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

I. District wide Facilities bond on June ballot "Measure C" Bill Holt will Spearhead.

- 55% vote will decide and the money can't be taken back from the state.
- Provides critical support for our schools and programs
- Generate \$7-8 million dollars in revenue
- 15 phone banking nights
- Each school in the district will work one night and walk once • Sat. May 8 and June 5.
 - Instructional enhancements
 - Technology
 - Improve facilities
 - Provide safe places for after school programs
 - Improve energy efficiency

II. School closures and possible consolidation will definitely happen.

- A committee made up of 35 people.
- Each site will have 4 representatives
 - Caregiver, teacher, parent and community representative
 - 24 reps will come from feeder pattern school.
 - Applications need to be turned in May 7
