

#### Mt. Diablo USD Registered Voters: 141,456


- Telephone survey was conducted from March 14th through 18th

- Margin of error for the survey is +/- 4.9%






#### 38% of District Voters Have Never Had Children/Grandchildren in the District

Do you have or have you ever had any children or grandchildren who attended or are now attending a school in the Mt. Diablo Unified School District?




In your opinion, is the education at the schools in your community headed in the right direction or the wrong direction?





## **Quality of Education**



## **Quality of Fiscal Responsibility**


How would you rate the quality of fiscal responsibility of the Mt. Diablo Unified School District compared to the quality of fiscal responsibility in the surrounding communities?





## **Schools as a Community Asset**


Do you agree or disagree with this statement: "Our local public schools are the most important asset in our community and should be our number one priority."

Do you agree or disagree with this statement: "Quality schools increase property values."







#### **Voter Support (Before Information): 61%**


"To improve and repair aging classrooms and infrastructure including leaky roofs, plumbing, electrical wiring and air conditioning; expand science and technology classrooms; improve student safety and campus security; and qualify for State matching funds, shall Mt. Diablo Unified School District issue \$210 million of bonds with an estimated levy of 1.5 cents per \$100 of assessed valuation, averaging \$15 million per year while the bonds are outstanding, at legal rates, with annual audits and independent taxpayer oversight?"







#### **Tax Rate Sensitivity**


The bond would cost property owners (1.5 cents/\$15) per \$100/\$100,000 of assessed valuation per year in property taxes.





#### **Tax Rate Sensitivity**


The bond would cost property owners (2.5 cents/\$25) per \$100/\$100,000 of assessed valuation per year in property taxes.





### **Voter Support (After Information): 63%**


