

Rationale for NPS Contracts for 2011-2012 (Program Code 1660)

The Non-Public School (NPS) contracts are approved by the Board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2011 and reviewed and adjusted several times during the fiscal year. Changes to contracts are required due to graduation, changes in residency, students entering and leaving placements, increase or decrease in intensity of services, and corrective actions and settlement agreements to assure a free and appropriate public education.

There are a total of 213 students placed in Non-Public Schools. Eleven are entering as of July 1, 2011 for the following reasons:

Administrative Interim Placements – Students who enter the district with an IEP must be placed in programs based on their previous IEPs. Therefore, three students have entered the District and will be continued in NPS placement until a thirty day review is completed.

Home & Hospital Placements – Six students are receiving Home & Hospital services, pending agreement on a more appropriate placement.

Due Process Placements – Four student placements were determined by Due Process and Local Alternative Dispute Resolution mediation.

Graduation – Three students will receive high school diplomas for their respective NPS placements
