## Concord High School (Proposed in CCAP Grant)

### Cal-GETC Pathway (formerly [IGETC](#))

This pathway provides students with the opportunity to start taking classes in the general education pathway for California Community College Students to fulfill lower-division general education requirements necessary for transfer and admission to both the California State University and the University of California.
