  - Mt. Diablo Unified School District: 1. Provide within 18 days of increased minutes, the time equal to the normally provided 20 days as required by **CCR**, **Title 5**, **Section 3043 (g) (1)**; **and 2)** only 18 days of special education average daily attendance (ADA) may be claimed for this serviced.
- Mt. Diablo Unified School District is requesting to reduce the number of ESY days from 20 days at 3 hours per day to 18 days at 3.5 hours per day.
- Mt. Diablo Unified School District's academic calendar for 2021-2022 ESY does not permit 20 days for ESY prior to the July 4th holiday. Our experience has been that student would be far less likely to attend for the one day after the holiday after a three day break. In addition, staffing for ESY is a challenge and staff have indicated they are less likely to sign up to teach if the session ends after July 5th which will exacerbate our existing ESY staffing shortages.

In addition, Mt. Diablo Unified believes the new schedule amounts to an increase in instructional time and a decreased amount of time spent on transportation.

8. Demographic Information:
(District/school/program) Mt. Diablo Unified School District has approximately 1200 students who are eligible for extended school year with an average of 800 typically electing to attend annually. Students reside across seven different municipalities and are from ages 3-22.
