




#### 2020-2021 Pilot Year

#### 2021-2022 Pilot Year

Complete 3 capstone projects (PSA, Comic Strip, and Script using Pixar Story Spine

90% of the students passed the Adobe Certified Professional Certification in Photoshop

Learned Industry Standard Animation software ToonBoom Harmony & Storyboard Pro.

Learned Adobe Premier to help with creating professional introductions and credits for their animations.
