- **ArchiTexture:** In this lesson, you will learn about texture while creating an illuminated paper village. With this box your child will discover one of the exciting and necessary 7 elements of art! Learn about texture while creating an illuminated, enchanted paper village!
- **Surreal Perspectives:** In this project, young artists will have SO much fun creating their own original, surreal scene. While learning about Surrealism, they will learn about perspective and space in art.
- **Moxie Manga:** In this fun lesson students will have an introduction to manga while designing their own accordion-style book or "Orihon." There is a "Roll-a-Manga" dice

game included to get their creative juices flowing in a fun way and to encourage variety. As a bonus, they will have a small introduction to Japanese Kanji symbols and calligraphy.

- **Faux Stained Glass:** This project teaches about the art and history of stained glass while providing instructions to create faux pieces which will cling to any window or mirror. Your child will be guided to explore and generate an imaginative design producing an original piece of art offering a beautiful light reflection.
- **Face Vase:** Watch your seeds grow while learning basic clay techniques to create these wonderful vases. Students will create expressive, colorful and vibrant sculptures. Multidimensional masterpieces and endless outcomes!
