

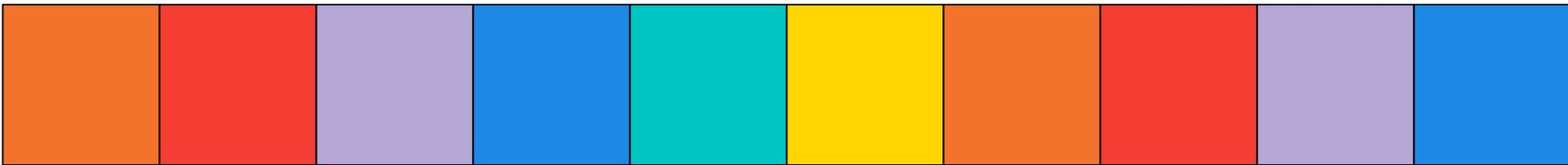

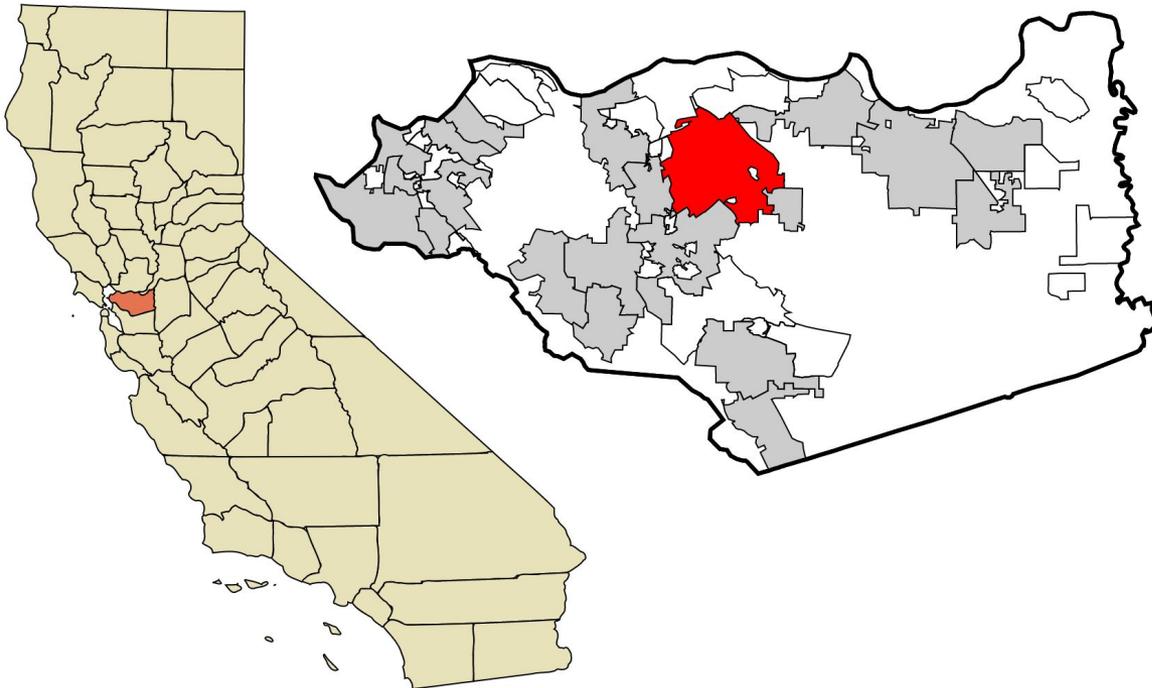
AVERAGE FIRST YEAR STUDENT GROWTH

NWEA™, the Northwest Evaluation Association, and its MAP Growth™ nationally-normed assessment, is used by more than 8,000 schools and districts throughout the world. Rocketship students take the MAP assessment in the fall, winter, and spring. Our Rocketeers grow more than a full grade level in a single school year, ever year. Last year, our new Rocketeers grew an average of 1.62 grade levels in math and 1.43 in reading.

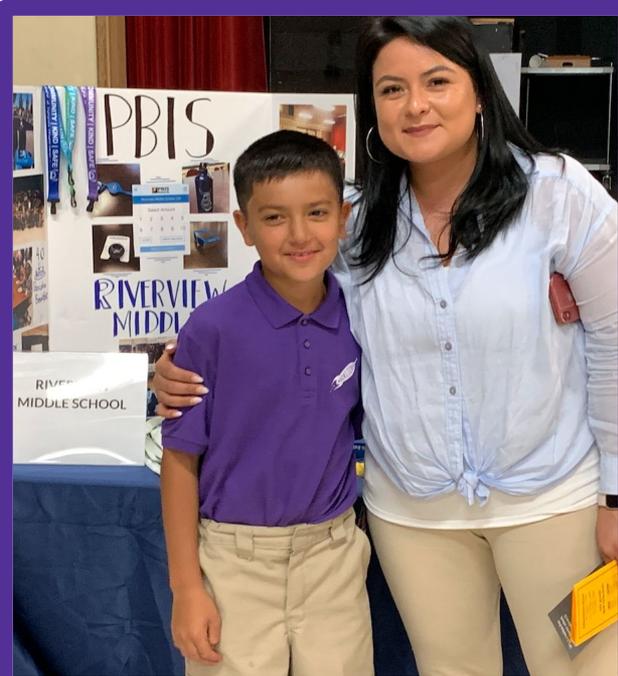
Parent partnership and engagement. Cafecitos, home visits, daily morning Launch meetings, parents volunteering on campus.

4-5 Hours of Daily Live Teaching

Every day, Rocketeers will have live teaching to promote student engagement, social emotional development, and interaction with classmates.



Small Group Instruction

Teachers will provide small group instruction daily to ensure we meet the individual needs of each and every Rocketeer.



On-Demand Learning

We'll continue to produce recorded content for our Rocketeers and use our online learning programs and Rocketship Goals platform to support independent learning that can adapt to your family's schedule. Every Friday will be a full day of on-demand and independent student learning.

Rocketeers at Home, at School, and in our Community

School closures due to the Covid-19 crisis disproportionately impact disadvantaged students of color. The New York Times reports, "Racial and socioeconomic achievement gaps will most likely widen because of disparities in access to computers, home internet connections and direct instruction from teachers."

Regular, bilingual wellness check for families. Texted daily (spring), bi-weekly (fall due to parent feedback), connecting families to rent assistance, food resources, tech help, etc.

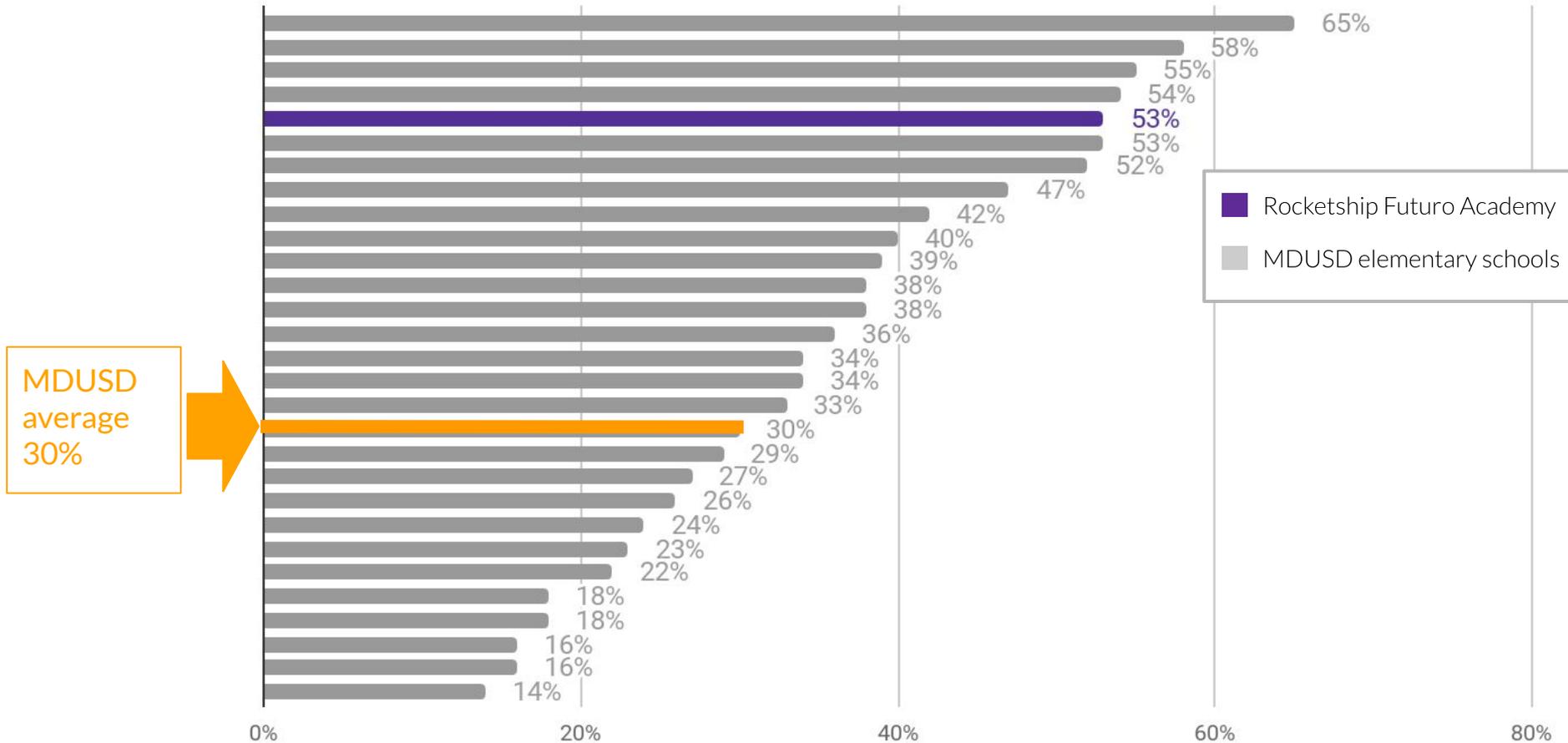

2018-19 CAASPP: Percent Met or Exceeded Standard Socioeconomically Disadvantaged Students, ELA Grades 3-5

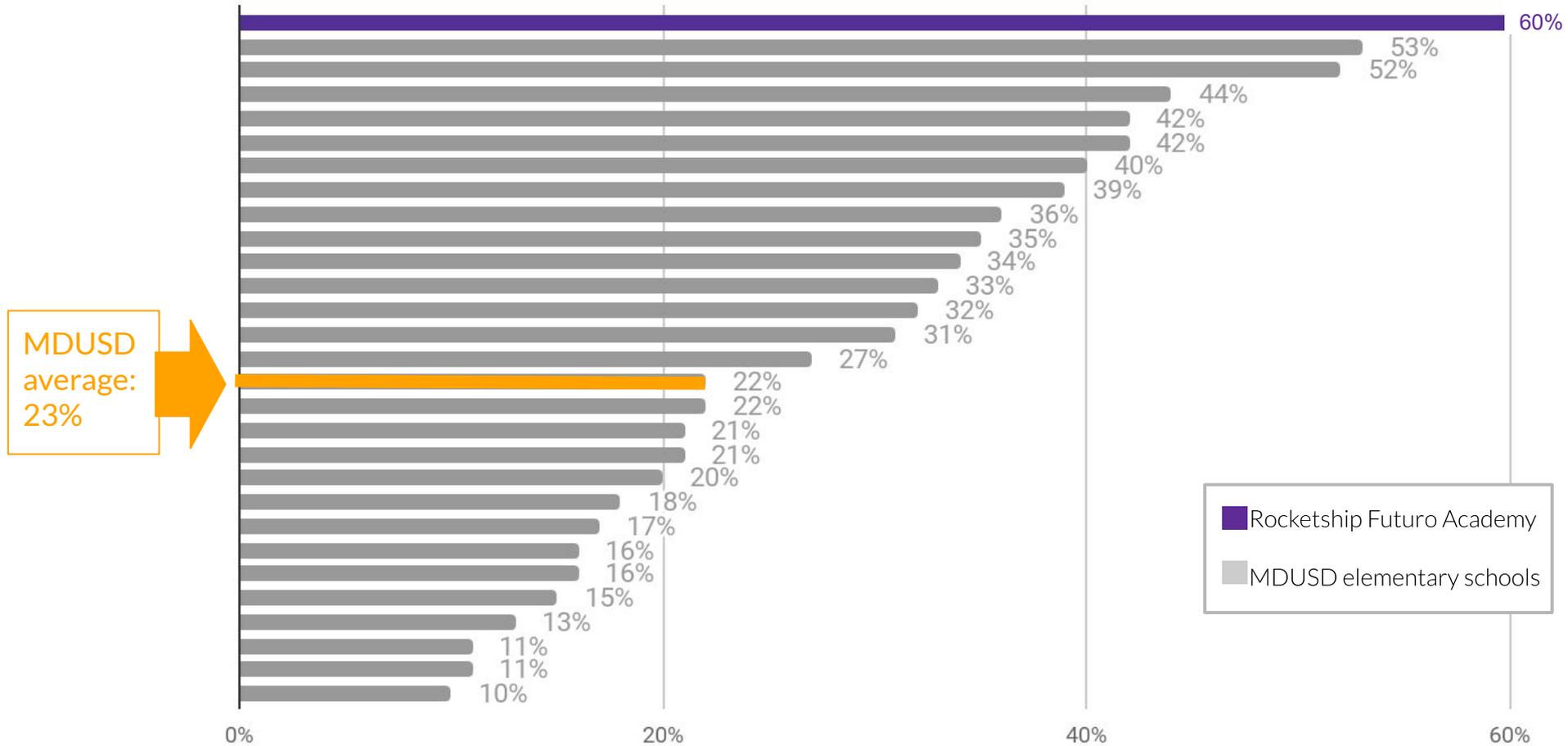

2018-19 CAASPP: Percent Met or Exceeded Standard Socioeconomically Disadvantaged Students, Math Grades 3-5

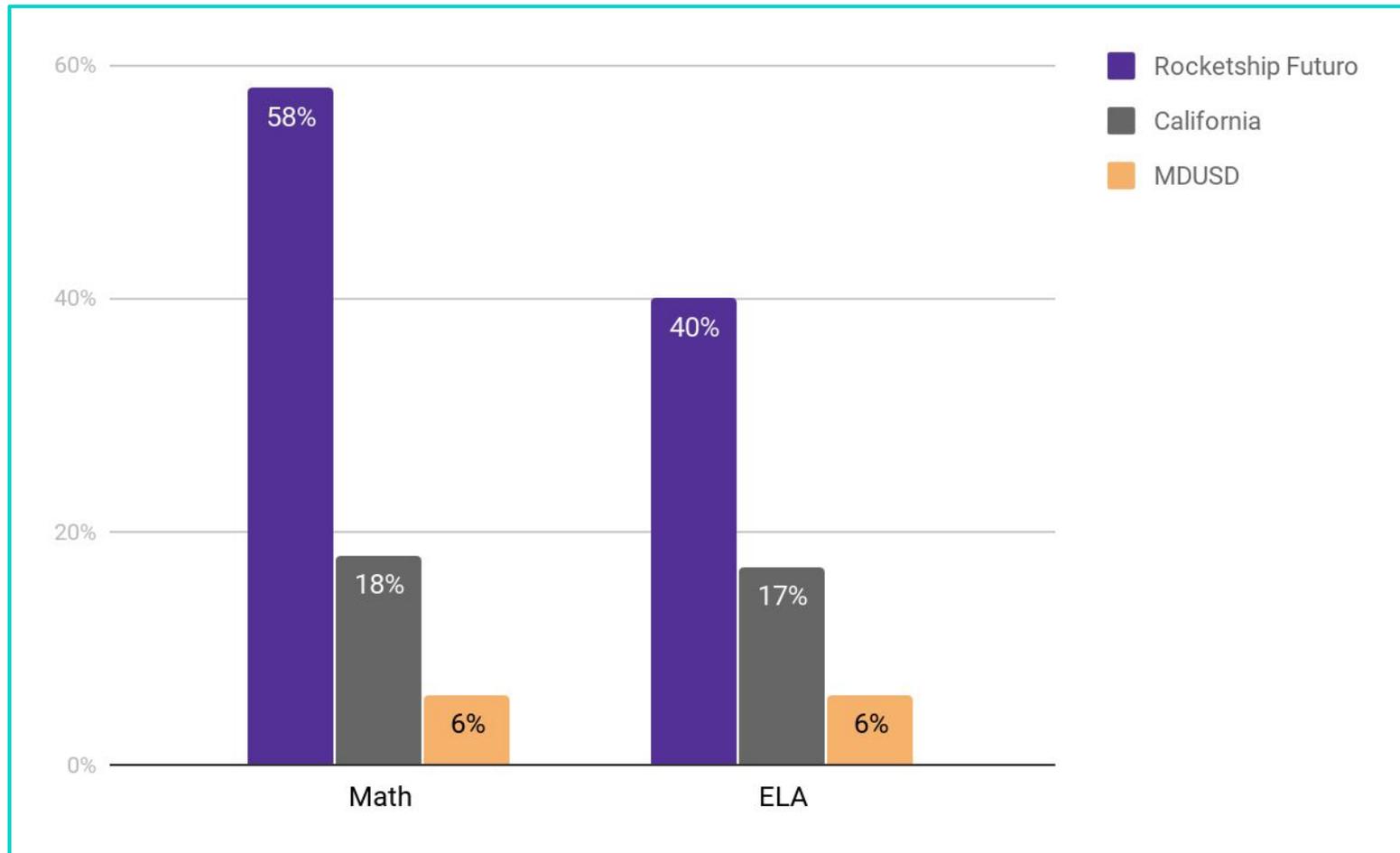

Rocketship Leads the Way on Top Bay Area Public Schools Report

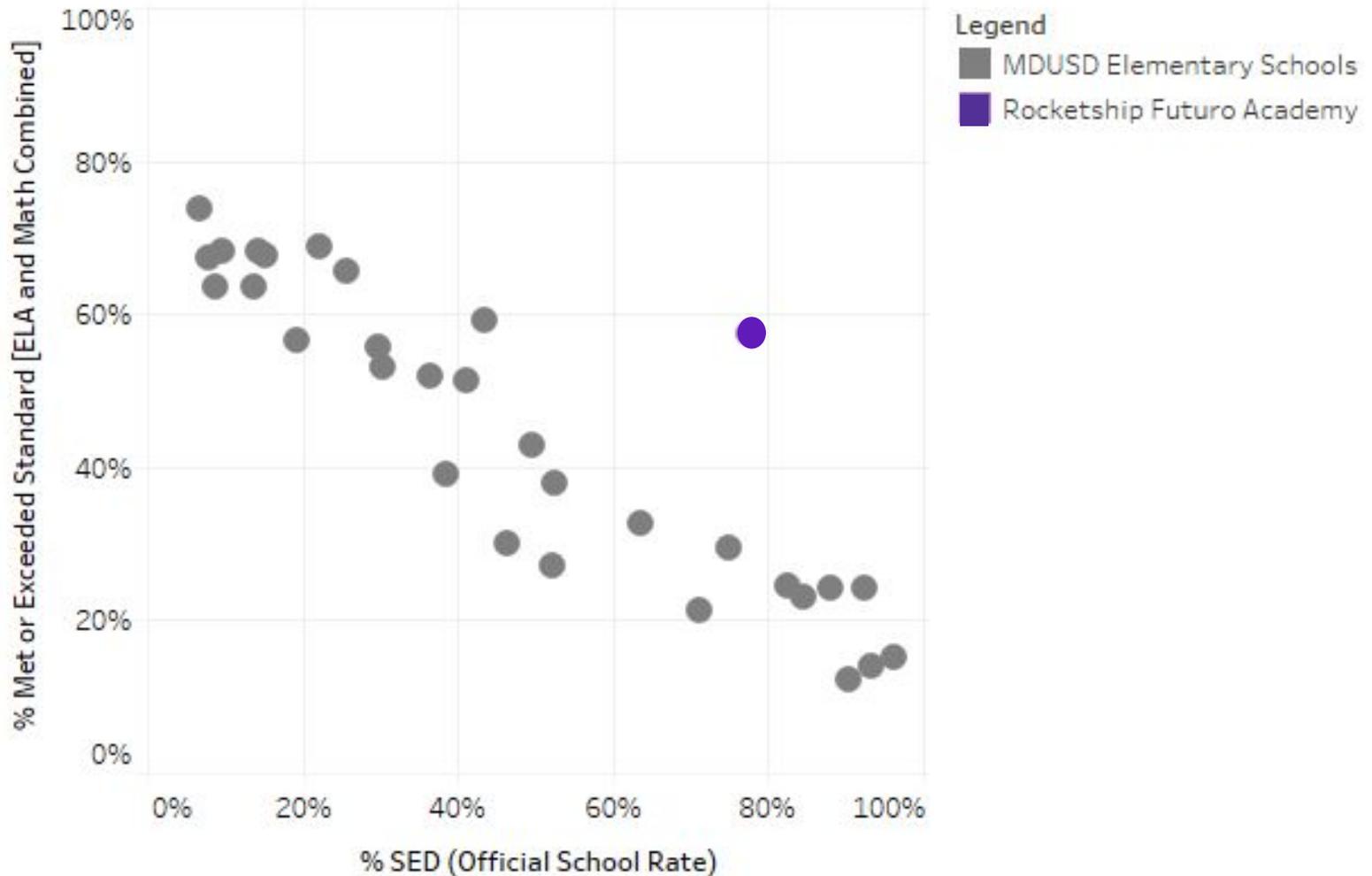
Rocketship Futuro Academy: one of the 26 public elementary schools in the Bay Area recognized as closing the gap for low-income Latino students in math.

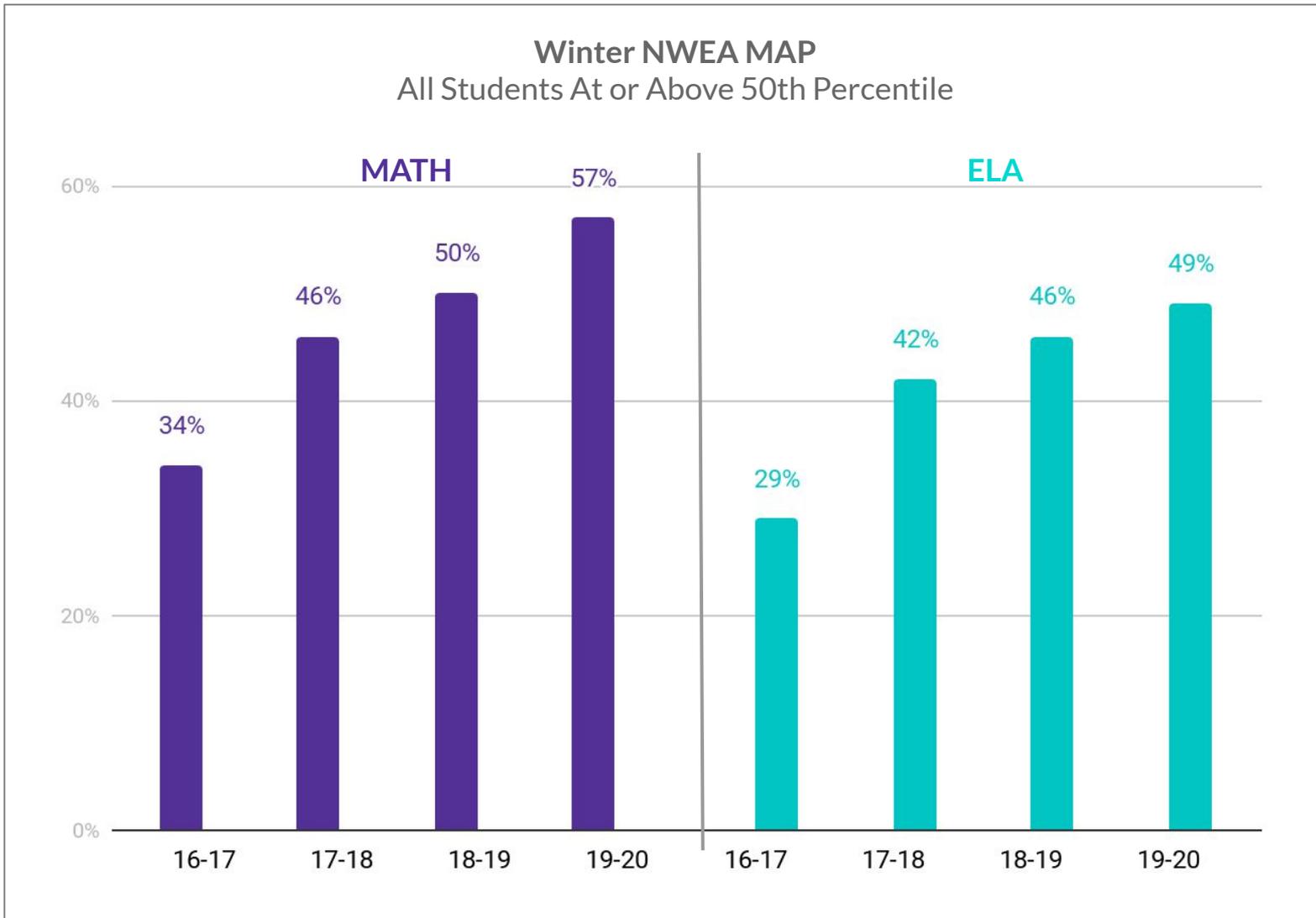
