Actions By The Board

Actions Requiring More Than A Majority Vote

Actions Requiring a Two-Thirds Vote of the Board:

1. Resolution declaring intention to sell or lease real property (Education Code 17466)

(cf. 3280 - Sale or Lease of District-Owned Real Property)

- Resolution declaring intent of Governing Board to convey or dedicate property to the state or any
 political subdivision for the purposes specified in Education Code <u>17556</u> (Education Code <u>17557</u>)
- 3. Resolution authorizing and directing the Board president, or any other presiding officer, secretary, or member, to execute a deed of dedication or conveyance of property to the state or a political subdivision (Education Code 17559)
- 4. Lease for up to three months of school property which has a residence on it and which cannot be developed for district purposes because funds are unavailable (Education Code <u>17481</u>)
- 5. Temporary borrowing before receipt of fiscal income, if implemented pursuant to Government Code <u>53820-53833</u> (Government Code <u>53821</u>)
- 6. Upon complying with Government Code <u>65352.2</u> and Public Resources Code <u>21151.2</u>, ordering city or county zoning ordinances inapplicable to a proposed use of the property by the district (Government Code <u>53094</u>)

- 7. Resolution to transfer excess local funds from a deferred maintenance fund when state funds are insufficient to match local funds being held in the deferred maintenance fund (Education Code 17582, 17583)
- 8. For districts desiring to operate a community day school on an existing school site to serve grades K-6 (and no higher grades), certification that satisfactory alternative facilities are not available for a community day school (Education Code 48661)

9. Resolution **of intent** to issue general obligation bonds with the approval of 55 percent of the voters of the district (Education Code <u>15266</u>)

Actions Requiring a Two-Thirds Vote of the Board Members Present at the Meeting:

- 1. Determination that there is a need to take immediate action and that the need for action came to the district's attention after the posting of the agenda. If less than two-thirds of the Board members are present at the meeting, a unanimous vote of all members present is required. (Government Code 54954.2)
- 2. Determination that a closed session is necessary during an emergency meeting. If less than two-thirds of the Board members are present, a unanimous vote of all members present is required. (Government Code <u>54956.5</u>)

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Actions Requiring a Four-Fifths Vote of the Board:

1. The expenditure and transfer of necessary funds and use of district property or personnel to meet a national or local emergency created by war, military, naval, or air attack, or sabotage, or to provide for adequate national or local defense (Government Code <u>53790-53792</u>)

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- 2. Resolution, adopted between July 15 and August 30, to borrow funds of up to 25 percent of the estimated income and revenue to be received by the district during the current fiscal year from apportionments based on average daily attendance for the preceding school year (Government Code 53822-53824)
- 3. Declaration of an emergency in order to authorize the district to include a particular brand name or product in a bid specification (Public Contract Code 3400)

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Actions Requiring a Unanimous Vote of the Board:

1. Resolution authorizing and prescribing the terms of a community lease for extraction of gas

(Education Code <u>17510-17511</u>)

2. Waiver of the competitive bid process pursuant to Public Contract Code <u>20111</u> when the Board determines that an emergency exists and upon approval of the County Superintendent of Schools (Public Contract Code 20113)

Action Requiring a Unanimous Vote of the Board Members Present at the Meeting:

1. Private sale of surplus property without advertisement in order to establish that such property is not worth more than \$2,500. Disposal of surplus property in the local dump or donation to a charitable organization requires the unanimous vote of the Board members present to establish that the value of such property would not defray the cost of arranging its sale. (Education Code 17546)
