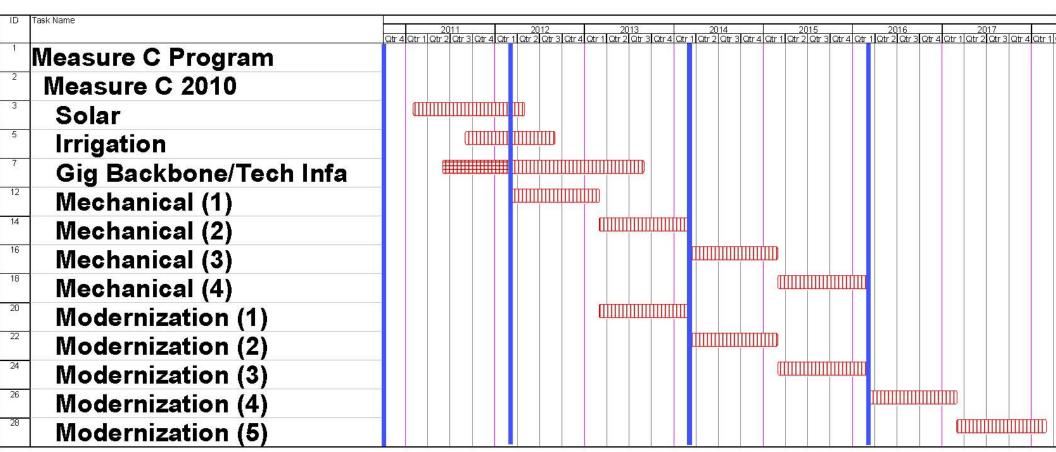

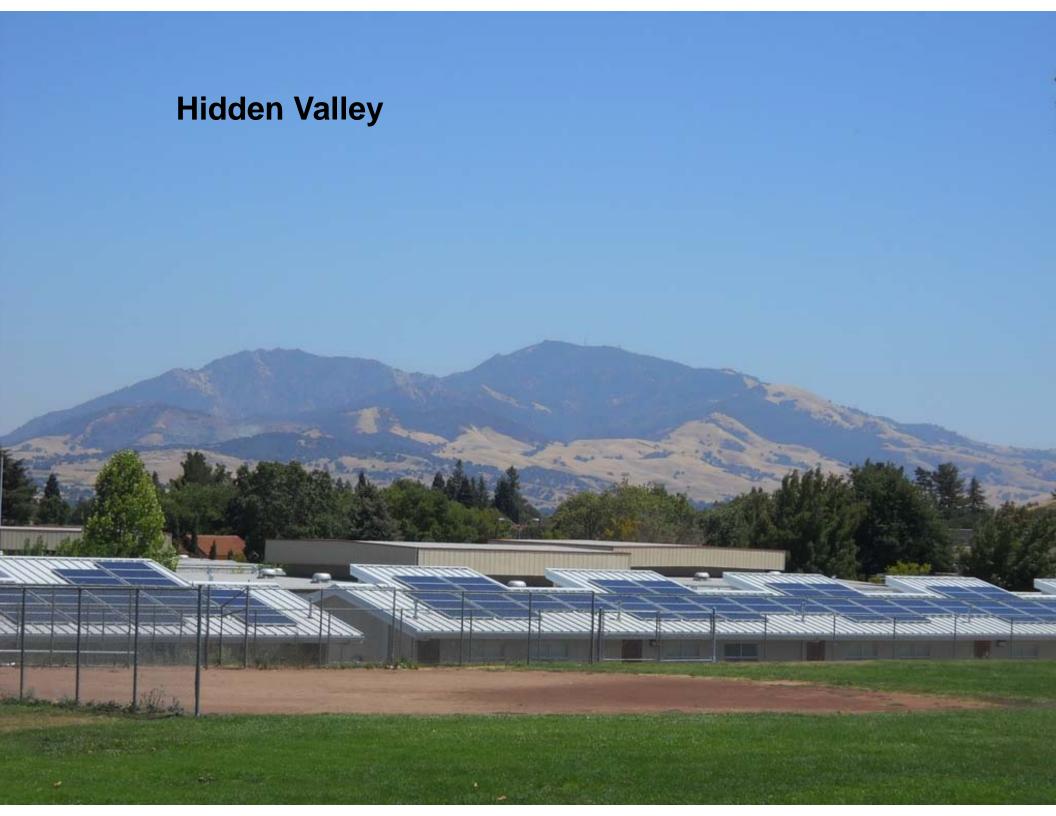

- \$1,690,071.17 received in CSI payments as of 9/17/2012







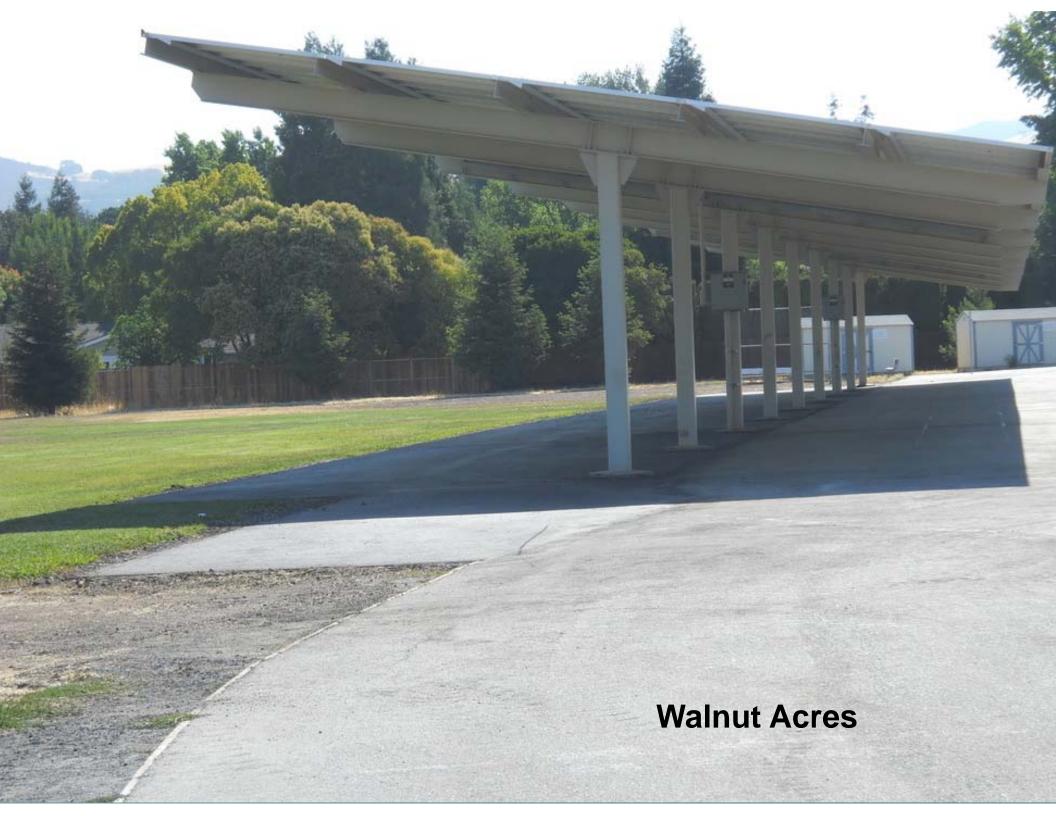

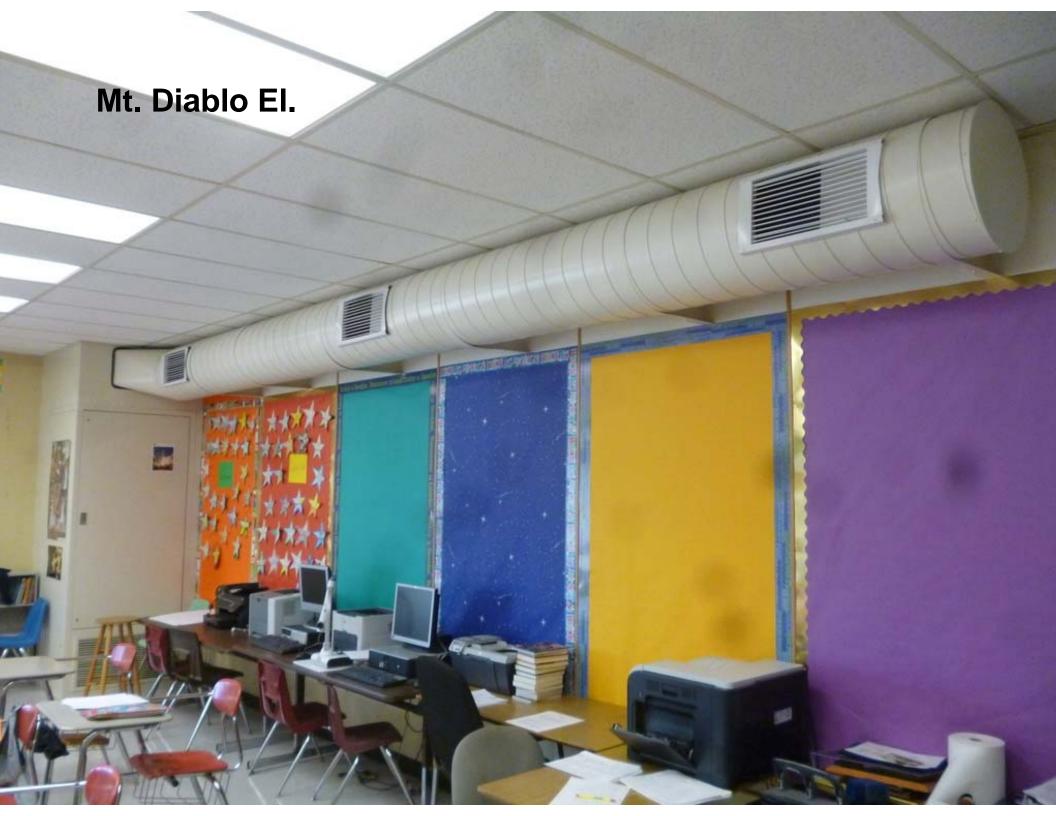

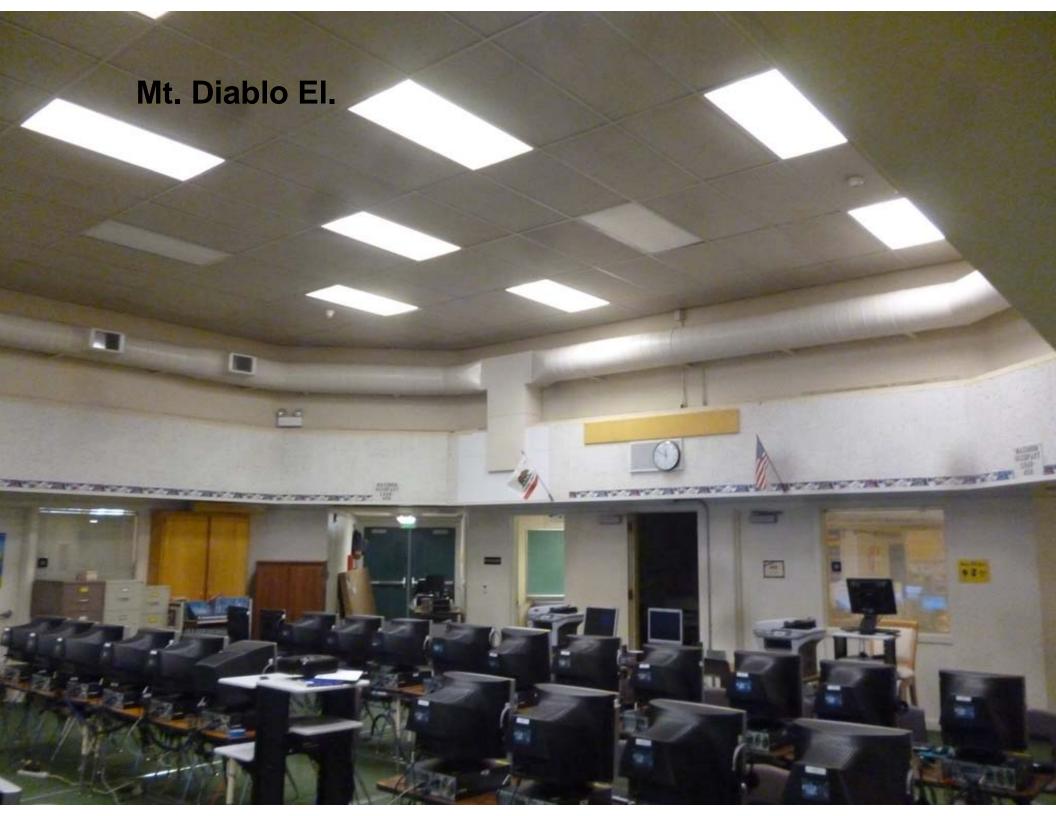
2012-2015 to 2012-2014

Mechanical (HVAC)

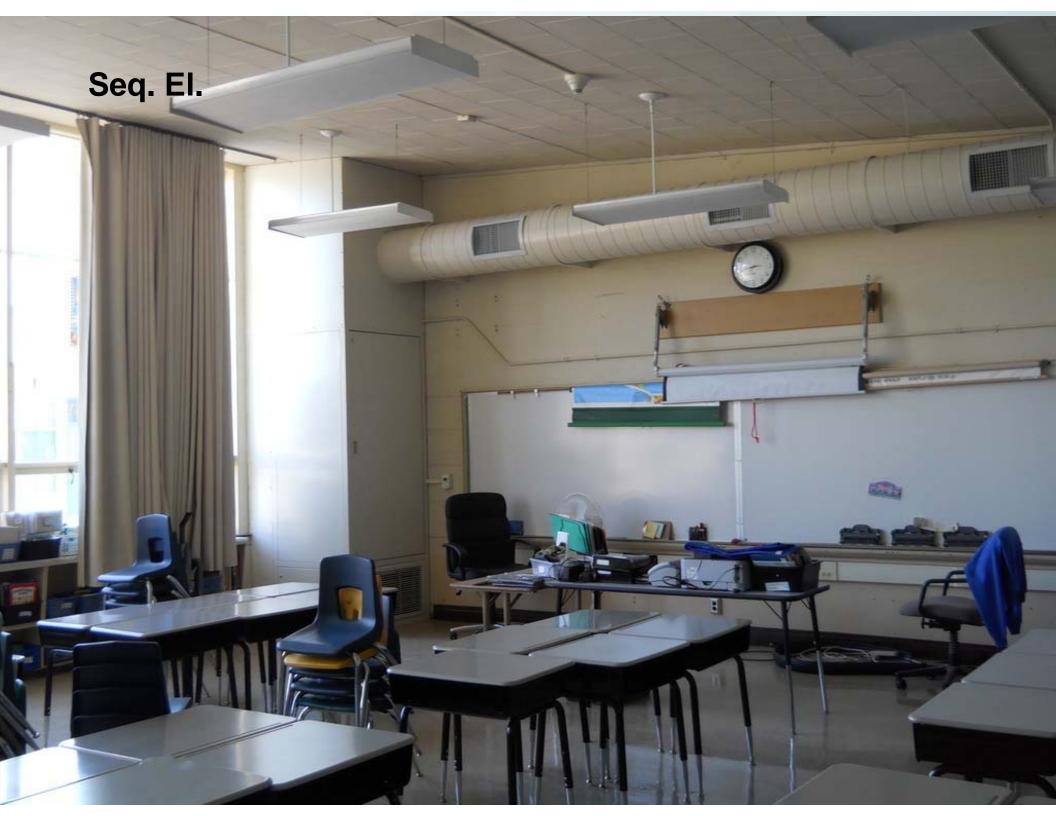

- Bid Award: early 2013.





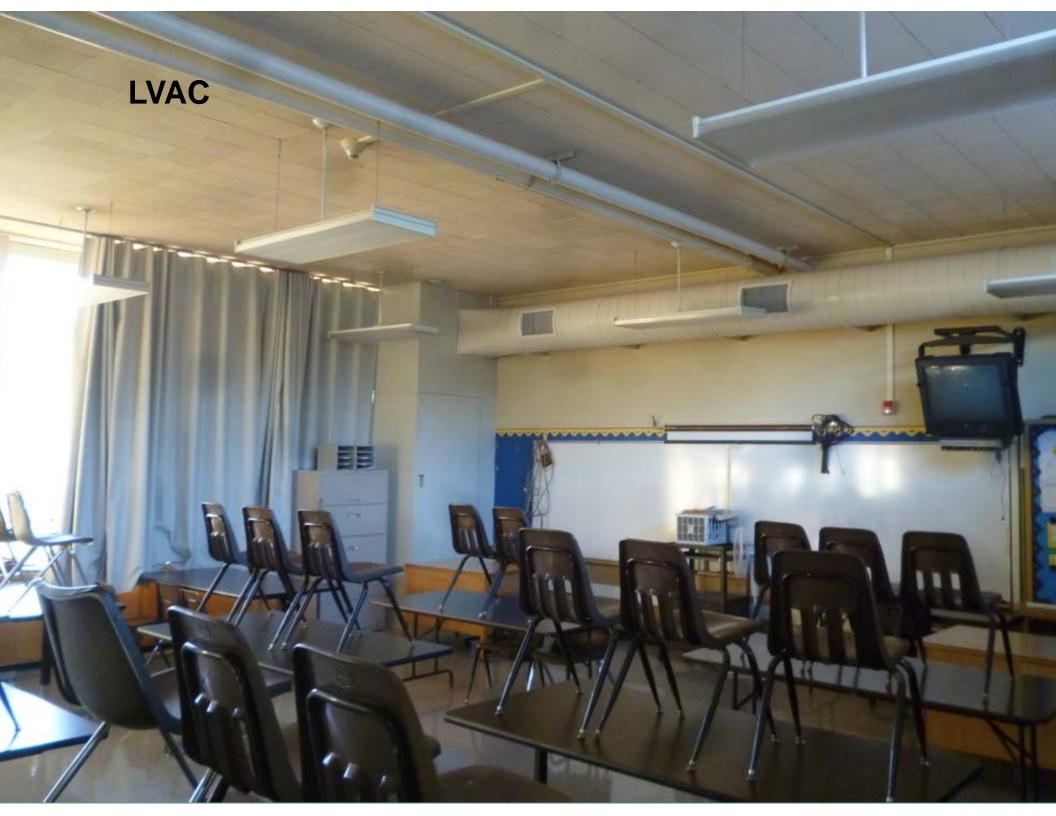












Technology Infrastructure

- Opteman (High Speed Internet) installation nearly complete (3 site remaining). Completion expected in October, 2012.
- Electrical/HVAC Upgrades to MDF's and IDF's complete
- Structured cabling (secondary sites): Bid award pending. Installation scheduled for completion in April 2013.
- Structured cabling (elementary sites): 50% design.

- Construction tentatively scheduled to commence in July, 2013 and be fully completed by August, 2014

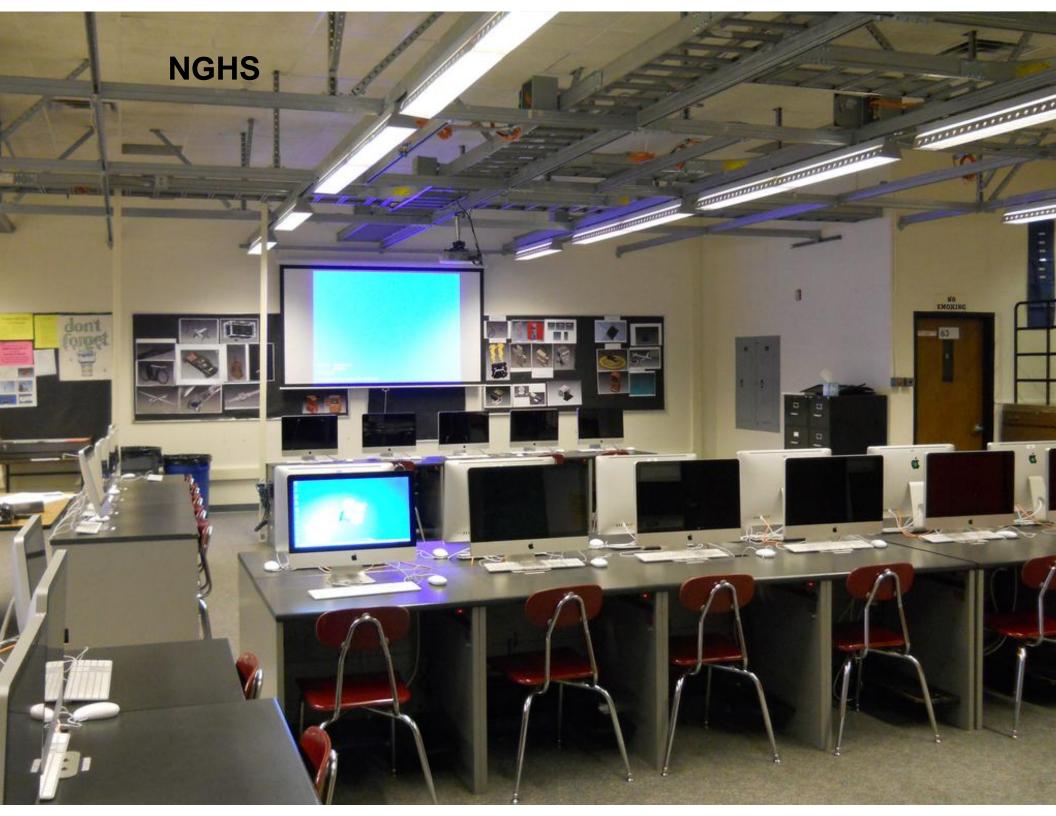

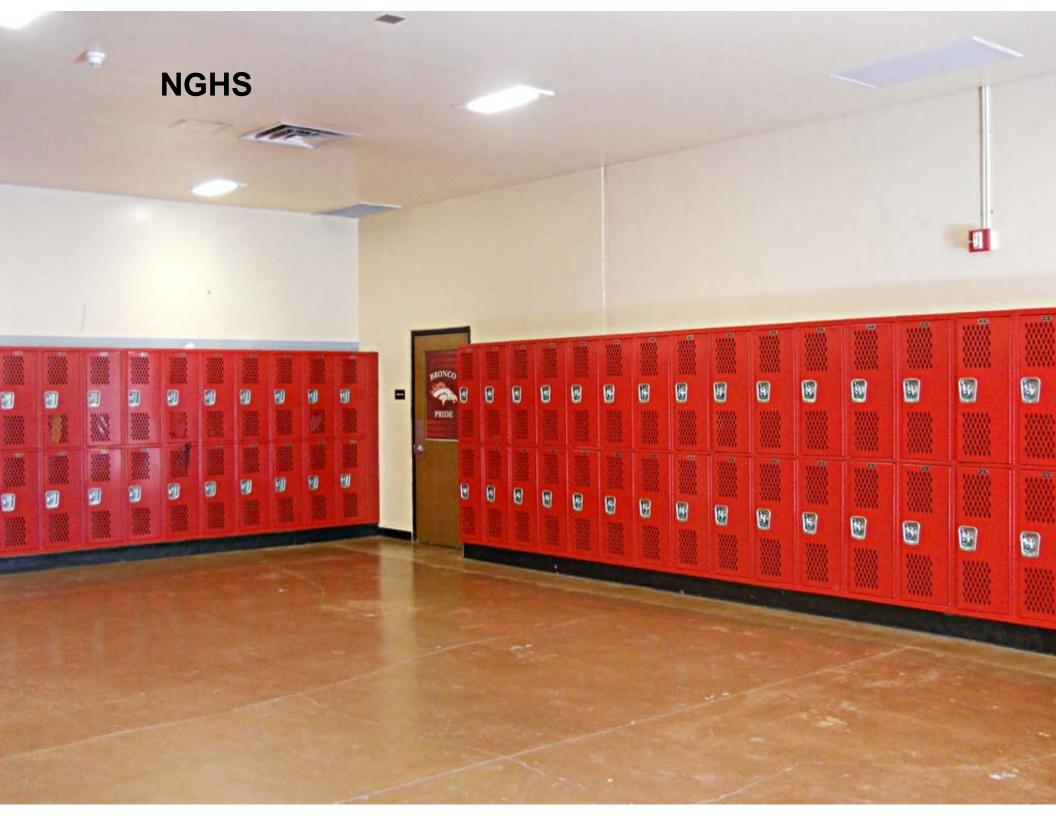

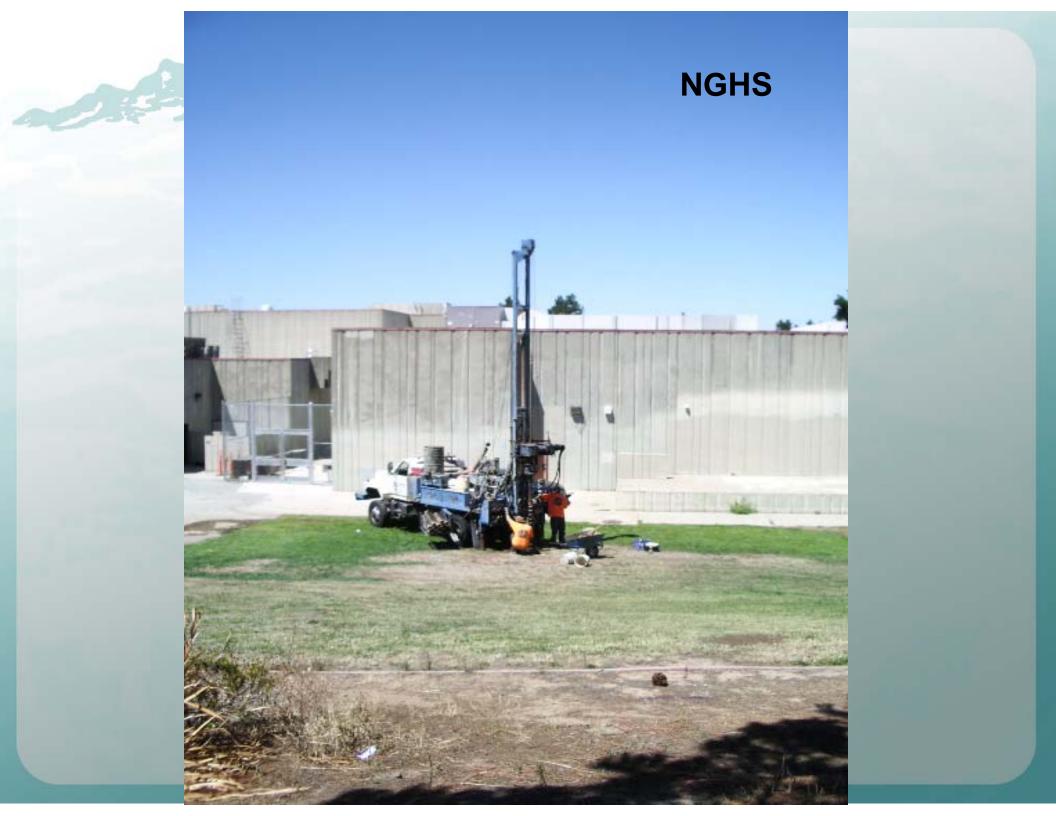
