WHEREAS, the title "school administrator" is a broad term used to define many education leadership posts, which include the district executive team, principals, assistant principals, special education and adult education leaders, curriculum and assessment leaders, school business officials, classified educational leaders, and other school district employees; and

WHEREAS, administrators set the tone for the school or their division/departments and advocate for ALL students and ensure that students are supported through a multitiered system of support, and

WHEREAS, certificated and classified administrators provide leadership for the educational program by supporting the development and implementation of a challenging curriculum and selection of appropriate textbooks and instructional materials; and

WHEREAS, administrators are responsible for recruiting, training, and evaluating certificated and classified staff; managing and maximizing limited budgets, implementing school board policies and complying with federal, state, and local regulations and laws, planning and maintaining school facilities, and providing transportation, nutrition, and social service programs to pupils and their families; and

WHEREAS, research shows that great administrators improve staff effectiveness; and

WHEREAS, local administrative teams include confidential employees who perform and assist in the performance of many critical functions; and

WHEREAS, Mt. Diablo Unified School District administrators have tackled a significant number of new challenges due to the COVID-19 pandemic and have gone above and beyond to lead and ensure that staff, students, and families are provided the best possible services and environments to be successful during these unprecedented times; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mt. Diablo Unified School District joins with the State Board of Education declaring October 9-15, 2022 the Week of the School Administrator and commends the many outstanding contributions and services provided by administrative teams in our public schools.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution be distributed to all schools within the district.
