Learning goals for participants (ie: what you want children to gain from the program):

Brief description of the schedule and expected activities, in addition to STEM:

CARES will operate a 6 hour per day program 8am to 2pm from June 25 to July 20 with July 4th as a holiday for a total of 19 days. Students will participate in 90 minutes of Tech Bridge curriculum daily in the morning before lunch. Additional activities will include: Cooking Taste Testings (Harvest of the Month) 2x/week, Nutrition Curriculum 2x/week (Harvest of the Month & Children's Power Play), Sparks, CATCH, Playworks activities, Life Skills, dance, swimming at the Concord Community Pool @ Cowell Park 1x/wk, minimum of 1 field trip to Chabot Space and Science, San Jose Tech Museum or Exploratorium.

Students will receive free breakfast & lunch daily.
