What is AVID?

Advancement Via Individual Determination

- A **schoolwide** college readiness system
- A structured approach to **rigorous** curriculum
- Direct support structure for **first-generation college students**
- **Professional learning** for educators

College Readiness Defined

- **College readiness:** the level of preparation a student needs to **enroll and succeed—without remediation**—in a credit-bearing general education course at a postsecondary institution that offers a baccalaureate degree or transfer to a baccalaureate program.

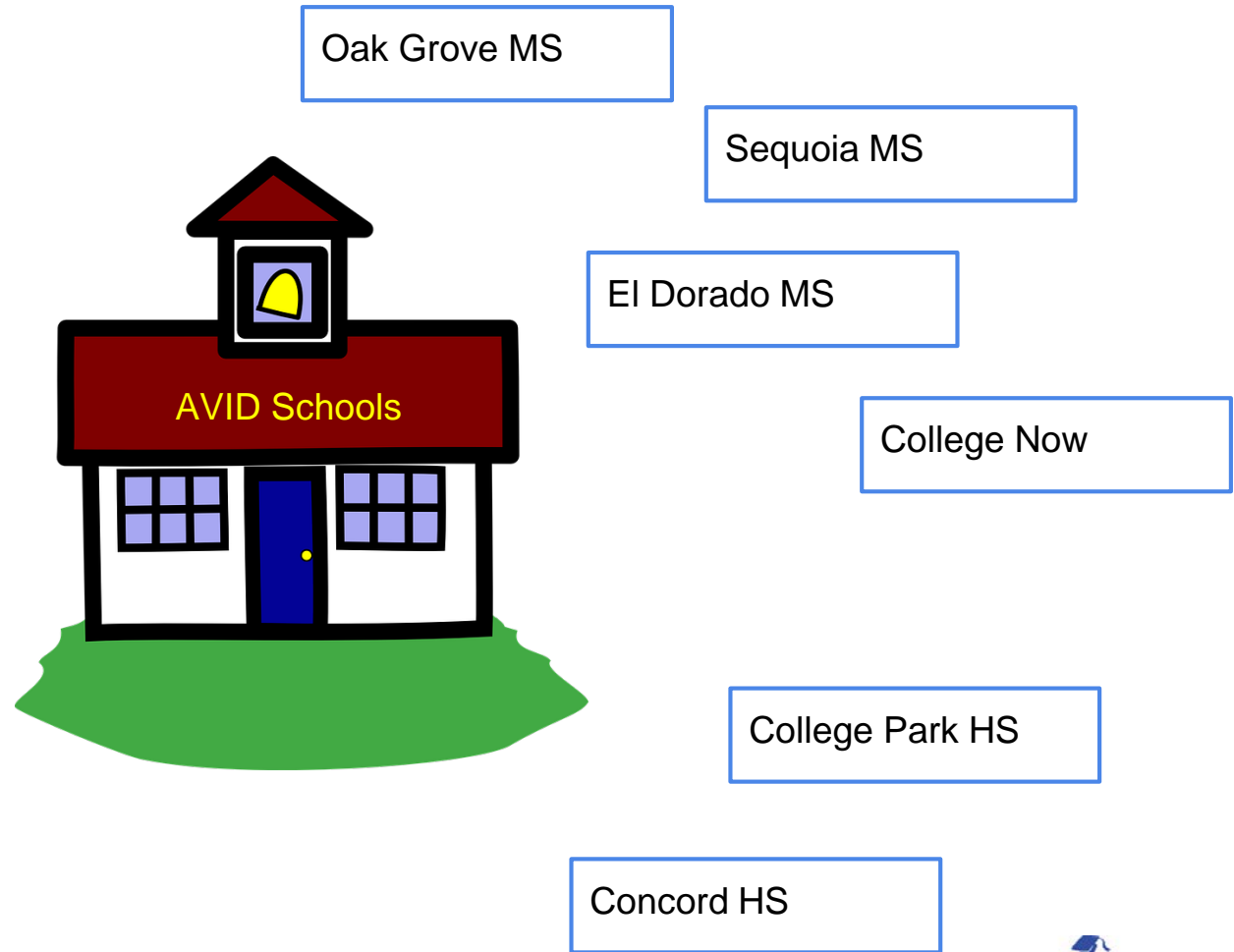

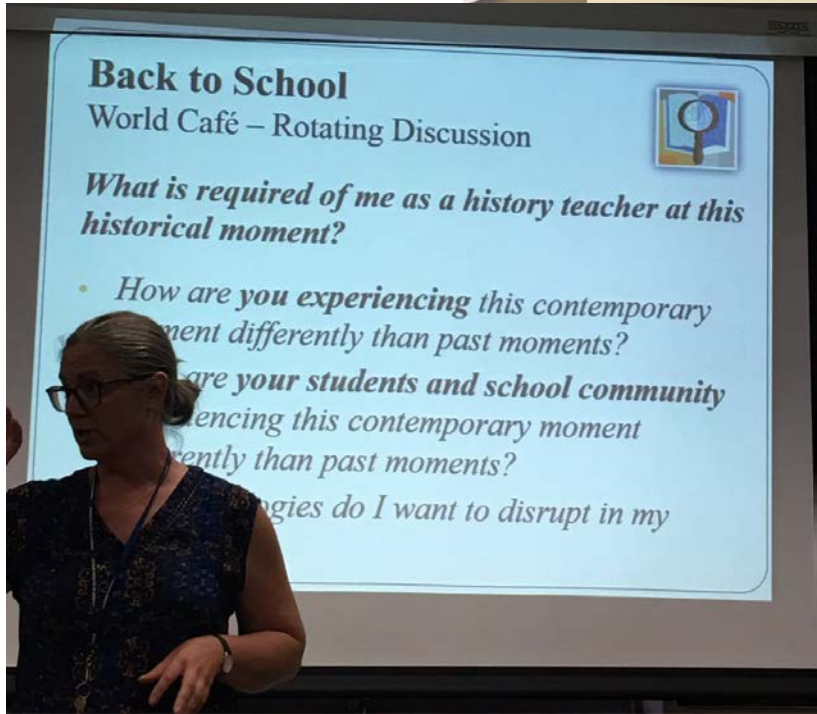
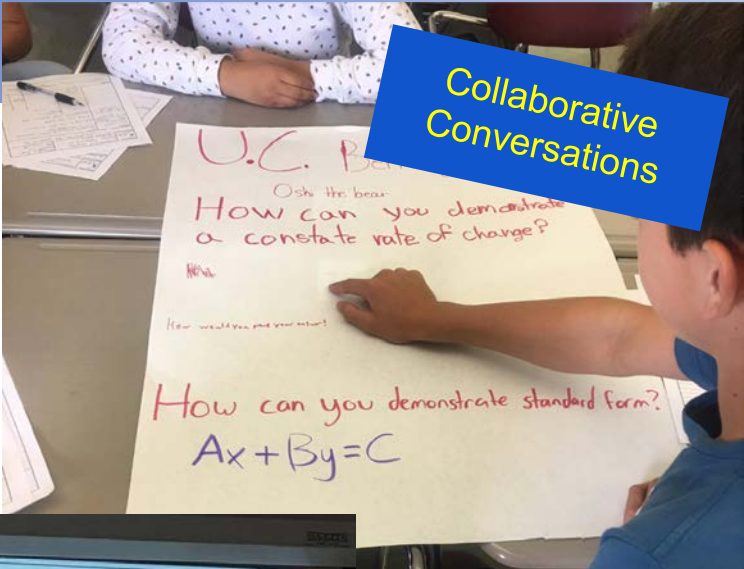
