Screeners

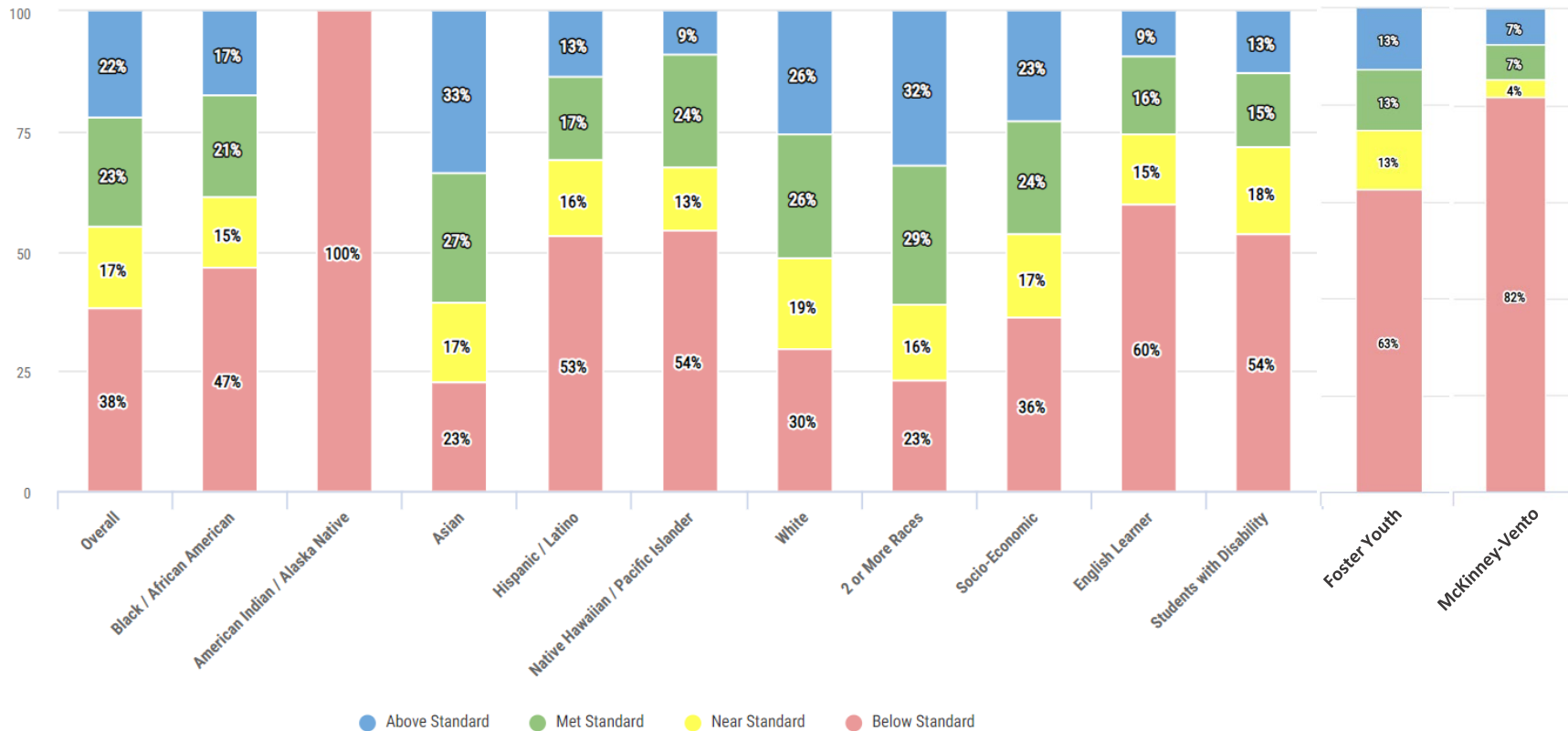
Used regularly to detect risk for reading disabilities including dyslexia (additional measures will be used to improve the validity as a dyslexia screener)

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Participation

85% of Kindergarten through Grade 2 completed the DIBELS literacy assessments

Overall Performance

- 45% of students were meeting or above benchmark standard
- 17% of students were near benchmark standard
- 38% of students were below benchmark standard

Focal Scholars

Black/African American students, Foster Youth, McKinney Vento, Students w/ Disabilities and Multilingual students all display larger distributions of students performing **below benchmark standard** by as much as **9% - 44%** compared to the overall students and smaller distributions of students performing **near, met, and above benchmark standard**.
