Purpose of the Two-Way Dual Immersion Program








History

- Two-Way Immersion Programs began in California between 1980 and 1986.
- There are approximately 422 programs in the U.S. in 31 states (including DC).
- In California we have over 200 dual immersion programs with 6 languages: Spanish, Cantonese, Mandarin, Korean, Japanese and Hmong.
