**Scope of Work**

**2014-2015**

The UC Berkeley History-Social Science Project proposes a scope of work with the history, VAPA, PE, world language, and CTE secondary teachers in the Mount Diablo Unified School District (approximately 265 teachers) to assist in discipline-specific implementation of the Common Core. Two all day workshops of programming, which introduce and embed a cycle of inquiry, will provide a foundational understanding of UCBHSSP's approach to explicit planning for discipline-specific thinking and literacy for participating teachers.
