

MaxFlo+, available in both solid core and perforated core, is a pre-fabricated system that consists of a formed expanded polypropylene core. It is a highly resilient closed-cell expanded bead product, and is an ideal energy absorbing material for sport surfaces that requires impact protection and shock absorption. The use of MaxFlo+ greatly reduces risk factors associated with poor subsurface soils.

Installation provides an uninterrupted vertical-to-horizontal flow path for superior rainfall evacuation and enhanced G-MAX performance without changing the ball-action or feel under-foot. The integrity of the systems expansion and contraction capabilities is maintained by the use of the GeoClip™ system which holds the MaxFlo+ in place during the installation of the turf system. The GeoClip also decreases the risk of wind negatively impacting the installation process. The GeoClip allows each individual pad to naturally react to changing temperature and humidity conditions while assuring the turf installation team is able to perform on a secure monolithic work surface. The proper installation of the MaxFlo+ system reduces G-MAX by up to 50 points.







The Stobitan® Full Pour RSS resurfacing running track system is a synthetic surface of 3-5 mm thickness, and suitable for all levels of competition. The system consists of multiple applications of flood and chip layers consisting of polyurethane and like-colored EPDM rubber granules to produce a textured surface. The Stobitan® Full Pour RSS system fully meets the performance requirements of NFHS and NCAA.



Installation of Stobitan® Full Pour RSS Surfacing

- **A.** Primer All existing surfacing is primed using 50/50 mixture of Stobielast® 135.00 + and low polar solvent such as aromatic 100 (1:1 w/w). Application rate is approximately 0.18 lbs/sy. Only the area to be covered within the working day should be primed to ensure a good bond to the existing surface.
- **B.** Retopping Layer One application of double mixed Stobielast® 154.XX polyurethane coating at approximately 6.65 lbs/sy is applied on top of the existing layer with a notched squeegee. After the material has self-leveled and is still liquid, colored 1-3.5 mm EPDM rubber granules are broadcast into the surface to excess. After curing (hardening), the excess colored EPDM granules are removed. Approximately 7.0 lbs/sy of EPDM should remain in the colored polyurethane.
- **C.** All methods for mixing of products are to be approved by STOCKMEIER Urethanes USA, Inc. and can be found on their Stobielast® Technical Data Sheet (TDS).

Line Markings

A. All line marking paint is to be approved by the synthetic surfacing manufacturer.

B. All markings will be in accordance to the desires of the owner.

MANUFACTURER'S LIMITED WARRANTY 12 YEARS NON-PRORATED TENCATE TUFTED TURF

PIVOT NON-INFILL

- 1. Limited warranty. Subject to the terms, conditions and limitations contained in this Limited Warranty, TenCate ("TenCate") warrants to the person, firm or entity indicated on the signature page hereof ("Purchaser"): That under normal, ordinary use the TenCate Pivot Non-Infill tufted turf product Purchaser acquired ("Product") will, for the Relevant Period as determined in Table A from the Substantial Completion Date, (1) be free from defects in material and workmanship and (2) with respect to the yarn component thereof, maintain UV-stability. The yarn component of the TenCate tufted turf Products acquired by Purchaser will be deemed to have maintained its UV-stability if (i) the original tensile strength of the Product does not decrease by more than fifty percent or (ii) the tuft bind strength is not less than 6 lbs/force during such normal and ordinary use for the identified applications herein. This warranty is only valid for the original installation pursuant to the terms and conditions herein. Purchaser must promptly inspect all Products upon delivery. Anything herein to the contrary notwithstanding, to the extent that any defects, shortages or non-conformities in the Products are discoverable by inspection upon delivery of the Products, all obligations of TenCate to Purchaser with respect to such defects, shortages and non-conformities unless Purchaser notifies TenCate of such defects, shortages, or non-conformities in writing within 30 days after the date of delivery.
- 2. **Remedy**. As Purchaser's sole and exclusive remedy should the Product fail to perform as warranted above, TenCate will, at its discretion, provide sufficient product to either replace (i) the affected area or (ii) the full field. If TenCate no longer offers the original Product, it will provide one of equivalent grade as that warranted hereunder. Replacement of Product shall not extend the Relevant Period. This Limited Warranty and the foregoing exclusive remedy do not include any costs associated with removal or disposal of defective product or the installation of replacement product and such costs are expressly disclaimed. IN NO EVENT SHALL THE OBLIGATIONS OF TENCATE HEREUNDER EXCEED THE ORIGINAL PURCHASE PRICE RECEIVED BY TENCATE FOR PRODUCTS WARRANTED HEREUNDER AND ACQUIRED BY PURCHASER.
- 3. Exclusions and Limitations on coverage. This warranty does not apply: (i) if the Product is used for any application other than a sports playing surface (i.e., football, lacrosse, hockey, soccer, rugby, baseball, softball, etc.) and the listed Intended Use; (ii) to any damage caused during or on account of improper processing, installation, or repair; and/or (iii) to the extent that any defect or damage is caused by: (a) Burns, cuts, accidents, vandalism, abuse, negligence, or neglect; (b) Improper design, type, or failure of the sub-base of the sports field or court; (c) Wear or abrasion caused by an inadequate or improper sub-base; (d) Use of infill products of an incorrect grade (according to accredited test institutes, such as ISA-Sport/Labosport, or other test institutes accredited by TenCate) or containing chemicals that cause or contribute to any chemical reaction that damages the yarn (such as, without limitation infill made in whole or in part from volcanic ash, including, but not limited to Clinoptilolite zeolite); (e) Use of inappropriate footwear (e.g., metal cleats, spikes or similar projections other than conventional rubber knob cleats designed for football, soccer, or baseball), flat soled shoes, or other sports equipment; (f) The playing surface being used other than for the purpose for which it was designed and installed; (g) Use of chemicals (including unapproved cleaning agents), herbicides or pesticides that cause a chemical reaction detrimental to the Product; (h) Use of improper cleaning methods; (i) Acts of God or other conditions beyond the reasonable control of TenCate (including, without limitation, accident, flood, fire, misuse, negligence, improper installation, improper storage, modification, alteration, tampering, vandalism); (j) Post fibrillation after or during installation for purposes other than to get the infill materials in place; (k) Failure to properly maintain, protect or repair the turf in accordance with the most recent TenCate Maintenance Manual applicable to the Product; (I) Inappropriate use of the Product as described in maintenance manuals published by TenCate; (m) Static or dynamic loads exceeding manufacturer specifications; (n) Normal or expected wear and tear (all synthetic turf is subject to normal or expected wear and tear. Normal or expected wear and tear is not a manufacturing defect and is not covered by this warranty. In addition to the factors mentioned above, wear and tear depends on, without limitation, the construction of the synthetic turf (fiber face weight, stitch rate, fiber pile height and gauge) and the intensity of use of the synthetic turf). (iv) if the Product is maintained and/or repaired at any time by anyone other than a service company authorized by TenCate to perform Product repair and/or maintenance and/or (v) if the Purchaser fails to clearly and legibly log all use, maintenance, repairs, and/or other upkeep performed on the field and fails to produce the log for inspection by TenCate upon request. (vi) Failure to adhere to Tencate approved installation techniques and approved installation materials will void warranty coverage. This Warranty does not cover wear in batters boxes, catchers boxes, around bases, down base paths and on artificial mounds; fiber loss less than 50% of total field mass; or Metal or steel spike damage to any portion of the turf. Field use of any type prior to signed certificate of completion will void the warranty. TenCate shall not be responsible for any warranty issued or made by any other person to third parties, including, without limitation, any warranty with respect to useful life...

- 4. Limitation of liability. This limited warranty is further conditioned on Purchaser submitting a claim under this warranty in writing within 30 days of discovery of an alleged defect, such written claim including proof of sale and installation date, name and address of the end-user, roll numbers and/or panel numbers affected, copies of maintenance records, location of installation, Product sample/fiber material, sample of infill material(s) and a minimum of three clear pictures showing the problem to: Warranty Dept., TenCate, 1131 Broadway St., Dayton, TN 37321. Once the complete claim has been received by TenCate, TenCate shall be allowed a reasonable amount of time to respond to the claim, including time to inspect the Product and the alleged defect(s) at the installation site during reasonable business hours, and to conduct such tests as TenCate in is discretion may deem necessary. TenCate shall also be allowed a reasonable opportunity to cure any alleged defect(s). TenCate shall not be responsible for any costs or expenses incurred by Purchaser or others with respect to any tests, inspections, or consultations conducted by Purchaser or others. TenCate shall be furnished copies of any and all written reports of any tests performed by or for the Purchaser and/or Owner. Said reports shall identify the name and address of the entity or individual that performed the tests made the basis of the reports.
- 7. **Modifications**. This warranty, together with the Sales Agreement for the project listed below, is the complete, final and exclusive agreement of the parties with respect to the quality and performance of the Products and any and all representations and warranties concerning the Products. In the event of a conflict between this warranty and the Sales Agreement, this warranty shall prevail.
