

Rationale for Residential Contracts for 2011-2012 (Program Code 1655)

The Non-Public School (NPS) contracts are approved by the Board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2011 and reviewed and adjusted several times during the fiscal year. Changes to contracts are required due to graduation, changes in residency, students entering and leaving placements, increase or decrease in intensity of services, and corrective actions and settlement agreements to assure a free and appropriate public education.

The breakdown of the 9 students entering and/or leaving residential placements are as follows:

Administrative Interim Placements – Students who enter the District with an IEP placed in residential programs based on their previous IEPs. Therefore, two students entered the District placed in residential NPS for which Mt. Diablo will be responsible after the end of Extended Year

Home & Hospital Placements – Four students are projected to need more restrictive placement which could include residential placement.

Due Process Placements – Two student placements are possible through Due Process/Mediation and local Alternative Dispute Resolution mediation.

Graduation/Discharge – Three students are projected to graduate or return from residential placement
