The undersigned declares the Notice to Bidders and the Instructions to Bidders have been read and agrees and proposes to furnish all necessary labor, materials, and equipment to perform and furnish all work in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Contract Documents and the Drawings and Specifications of "Project" Bid No. 1608: Paving Improvements at Concord High School

("Project") and will accept in full payment for that Work the following total lump sum amount, all taxes included:

Additives/Deductive Alternates

Alternate Number One: All tools, materials, labor and equipment necessary to provide and install paving section at the area indicated on within the contract documents, in particular sheet C3, as additive alternate.

Alternate Number Two: All tools, materials, labor and equipment necessary to provide for the relocation of two storage containers shown on sheet C3. Containers shall be relocated next to the eight foot fence located on the south side near the existing snack shack.

Descriptions of alternates are primarily scope definitions and do not necessarily detail the full range of materials and processes needed to complete the construction.

1. The Bidder's Base Bid includes the following unit prices, which the Bidder must provide unit pricing. District reserves the right to find bid non-responsive for failure to provide unit pricing;
 - a. Unit Pricing: All tools, material, labor, equipment and fees required to remove and dispose of native soil excavations \$40.00 per /cubic yard.

b. Unit Pricing: All tools, materials, labor, equipment and fees required to pave additional areas in accordance with the contract documents \$ 4.15 per/square foot.

2. The undersigned has reviewed the Work outlined in the Contract Documents and fully understands the scope of Work required in this Proposal, understands the construction and project management function(s) is described in the Contract Documents, and that each Bidder who is awarded a Contract shall be in fact a prime contractor, not a subcontractor, to the District, and agrees that its Proposal, if accepted by the District, will be the basis for the Bidder to enter into a contract with the District in accordance with the intent of the Contract Documents.
3. The undersigned has notified the District in writing of any discrepancies or omissions or of any doubt, questions, or ambiguities about the meaning of any of the Contract Documents, and has contacted the Construction Manager before bid date to verify the issuance of any clarifying Addenda.
4. The undersigned agrees to commence work under this Contract on the date established in the Contract Documents and to complete all work within the time specified in the Contract Documents.
5. All on-site construction work shall be completed within 30 calendar days from the date of the District's issued notice to proceed.
6. All punch work / record documents list shall be completed within 7 calendar days from the date on the established punch list.
7. The liquidated damages clause of the General Conditions and Agreement and the liquidated damages clause in the Instructions to Bidders is hereby acknowledged.
8. It is understood that the District reserves the right to reject this bid and that the bid shall remain open to acceptance and is irrevocable for a period of ninety (90) days.

10. Bidder acknowledges that the license required for performance of the Work is a A license.

11. The undersigned hereby certifies that Bidder is able to furnish labor that can work in harmony with all other elements of labor employed or to be employed on the Work.
12. The Bidder represents that it is competent, knowledgeable, and has special skills with respect to the nature, extent, and inherent conditions of the Work to be performed. Bidder further acknowledges that there are certain peculiar and inherent conditions existent in the construction of the Work which may create, during the Work, unusual or peculiar unsafe conditions hazardous to persons and property.
13. Bidder expressly acknowledges that it is aware of such peculiar risks and that it has the skill and experience to foresee and to adopt protective measures to adequately and safely perform the Work with respect to such hazards.
14. Bidder expressly acknowledges that it is aware that if a false claim is knowingly submitted (as the terms "claim" and "Knowingly" are defined in the California False Claims Act, Cal. Gov. Code, §12650 et seq.), the District will be entitled to civil remedies set forth in the California False Claim Act. It may also be considered fraud and the Contractor may be subject to criminal prosecution.

The undersigned Bidder certifies that it is, at the time of bidding, and shall be throughout the period of the contract, licensed by the State of California to do the type of work required under the terms of the Contract Documents. Bidder further certifies that it is regularly engaged in the general class and type of work called for in the Contract Documents.
