Proclamation of September as Attendance Awareness Month Resolution No.

WHEREAS good attendance is essential to student achievement and graduation, and we are committed to reducing chronic absenteeism rates, with a focus starting as early as kindergarten,

WHEREAS chronic absence - missing 10 percent or more of school for any reason including excused and unexcused absences, or just two of three days a month – data shows that chronic absenteeism can lead to poor academic achievement,

WHEREAS chronic absence can be significantly reduced when schools, parents and communities work together to monitor and promote good attendance and address hurdles that keep children from getting to school,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Mt. Diablo School District proclaims that our schools will stand with the nation in recognizing September as "Attendance Awareness Month." We hereby commit to our continued focus on reducing chronic absenteeism to give all children an equitable opportunity to learn, grow and thrive academically, emotional and socially.

Specifically, the Mt. Diablo Unified School will:

- Continue to build upon our work with site administrators to raise awareness that chronic absence is a proven early warning indicator of academic trouble and dropping out of school.
- Continue to partner with Contra Costa County of Education and Juvenile Justice System to provide schools and families with information, strategies and resources to reduce chronic absenteeism,
- Engage parents/guardians, schools, community partners, and the media to help spread the message that good attendance matters and help us come up with solutions to ensure that all students are in school daily because, "Every School Day Counts!"
