In Support of National School Breakfast Week March 4 - 8, 2024

WHEREAS, the National School Breakfast Program was made permanent by Congress in 1975 after being piloted in high need schools beginning in 1966; and

WHEREAS, research has indicated that students who eat breakfast have better attention and memory and reduced absenteeism; and

WHEREAS, March 4-8, 2024 is designated as National School Breakfast Week; and

WHEREAS, California became the first state in the nation to adopt universal school meals during the 2022-23 school year, so that all Mt. Diablo Unified School District students are able to participate in the school breakfast program at no cost; and

WHEREAS, Mt. Diablo Unified School District serves over 7,000 breakfasts daily and almost 1,300,000 breakfasts annually; and

WHEREAS, the Mt. Diablo Unified School District Board of Education continues to recognize and takes great pleasure in commending the Food Service team members who accept and meet the daily challenge of providing school breakfasts to our students;
