- **5E)** Set the expectation for the use of benchmark assessments at all levels to capture a clear understanding of student learning at a minimum, quarterly.


SIR Report Actions: Assessment and Accountability

impact instructional practices and student learning.


Social-Emotional Learning (SEL)

Grades 3 - 5 SEL Overall Results #2




Overall, about 63.8% of students in grades 3 - 5 reported high levels of SEL competencies, 29.2% mid levels, 5.0% low levels and 2.0% very low levels.

Middle School SEL Overall Results #2




Overall, about 44.5% of middle school students reported high levels of SEL competencies, 44.5% mid levels, 8.8% low levels and 2.2% very low levels.

Overall, about 41.1% of high school students reported high levels of SEL competencies, 48.1% mid levels, 8.1% low levels and 2.7% very low levels.


High School SEL Domain Results #2










