




2013-14 Average Teacher Compensation (Salary & Benefits)


2014-15 Average Teacher Compensation (Salary & Benefits)


2015-16 Average Teacher Compensation (Salary & Benefits)


2016-17 Average Teacher Compensation (Salary & Benefits)




2017-18 Average Teacher Compensation (Salary & Benefits)


2017-18 Average Kindergarten Class Size




2017-18 Average Grade 1 Class Size




2017-18 Average Grade 2 Class Size






2017-18 Average English Language Arts Class Size (Secondary Grades)




2017-18 Average History/Social Science Class Size (Secondary Grades)


2017-18 Average Math Class Size (Secondary Grades)
