Advancement Via Individual Determination

- A schoolwide college readiness system
- A structured approach to rigorous curriculum
- Direct support structure for first- generation college students
- Professional learning for educators



College Readiness Defined

 College readiness: the level of preparation a student needs to enroll and succeed—without remediation—in a credit-bearing general education course at a postsecondary institution that offers a baccalaureate degree or transfer to a baccalaureate program.

- Develops readers and writers
- Develops deep content knowledge
- Teaches content-specific strategies for reading, writing, thinking, and speaking
- Develops habits, skills, and behaviors to use knowledge and abilities
