

Rationale for NPS Contract Adjustments for End of Year Reconciliation

The Non-Public School (NPS) contracts are reviewed and adjusted several times during the fiscal year. Changes to contracts are required due to graduation, changes in residency, students entering and leaving placements, increase or decrease in intensity of services, and corrective actions and settlement agreements to assure a free and appropriate public education.

The breakdown of the 15 students entering Non-Public Schools Placements are as follows:

Administrative Interim Placements – Students who enter the district with an IEP must be placed in programs based on their previous IEPs. Therefore, five students entering the district were placed in NPS.

Home & Hospital Placements – Six students were placed in Home & Hospital until a more appropriate placement could be determined. After a comprehensive evaluation, it was determined that NPS was the most appropriate placement.

Due Process Placements – Four student placements were made as determined by Due Process and local Alternative Dispute Resolution mediation.
