**2014 RENEWAL APPLICATION CERTIFICATION FOR NONPUBLIC, NONSECTARIAN

Dear Nonpublic School/Agency Administrator,

This e-mail serves as confirmation the California Department of Education (CDE) has received your 2014 renewal application and certification fees. The massive amount of renewal applications received around the October 31 deadline often delays processing of all certifications by December 31, 2013. Your certification is among those that may not be processed prior to December 31, 2013.

In the interim, pursuant to Education Code Section 56366.1 (k)(2), the CDE is issuing a temporary 2014 certification which can be found in your California Accountability & Improvement System (CAIS) profile. If your application is not accepted and approved before June 30, 2014, certification may be denied and your nonpublic school or agency (NPS/A) certification status will appear as "not certified" on the Nonpublic Schools/Agencies database that is available to Special Education Local Plan Areas (SELPA), districts, regional centers, and the general public.

The SELPA and contracting districts should be provided with a copy of the temporary conditional certification from the Interagency-Nonpublic Schools/Agencies Unit by December 13, 2013. If the NPS/A does not provide the SELPA with a copy of the temporary certification as proof of renewal, the SELPA and/or contracting districts should assume that the NPS/A did not apply for 2014 certification renewal.

With respect to your certification, please be advised that failure to notify the CDE of any changes in: (1) credentialed/licensed staff; (2) ownership; (3) management and/or control of the agency; (4) major modification or relocation of facilities; or (5) significant modification of the program, such as classroom additions, may result in the suspension or revocation of this certification.
