- Administrative Interim Placements- Students who enter the district with an IEP must be placed in programs based on their previous IEPs. 2 students were placed in NPS through this process.
- Residential Placements- 1 student aged out of a residential program, 1 student stepped down and 1 student entered.
- Entering Placements-6 students were placed in an NPS following Special Education Management Team review and the determination that a more restrictive program was necessary to provide FAPE due to the intensity/severity of the disability.
- Increase funding for Spectrum Center by \$1,988,023.08. The number of students in the program has not increased. The previous budget administrator should have allocated this amount based on 2010-11 actual expenditures of \$4,836,028.50
- · Adjustments to frequency/intensity of Related Services for students at Oak Hill and Orion Academy
- Adjustment due to contracted rate increase at Star Academy
