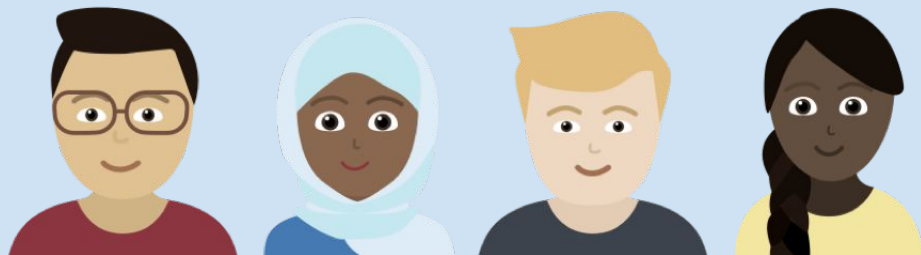




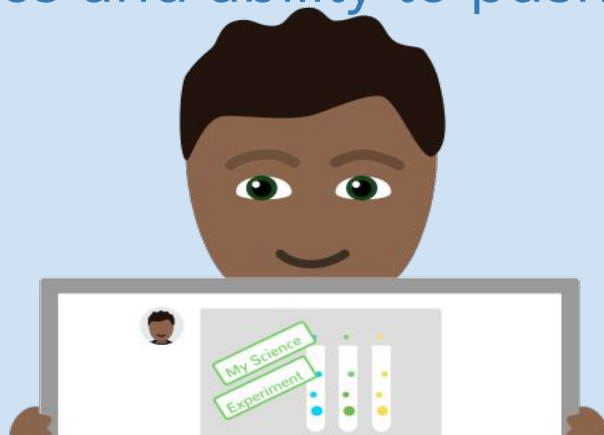

Why SeeSaw?

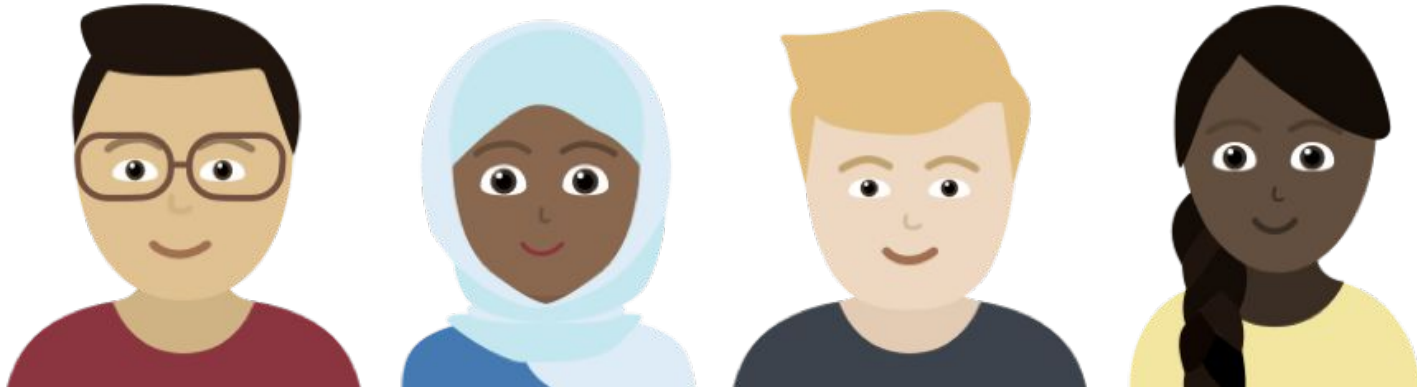
- Excellent for face-to-face and distance learning, transition is seamless

- District analytics and ability to push content and assessments



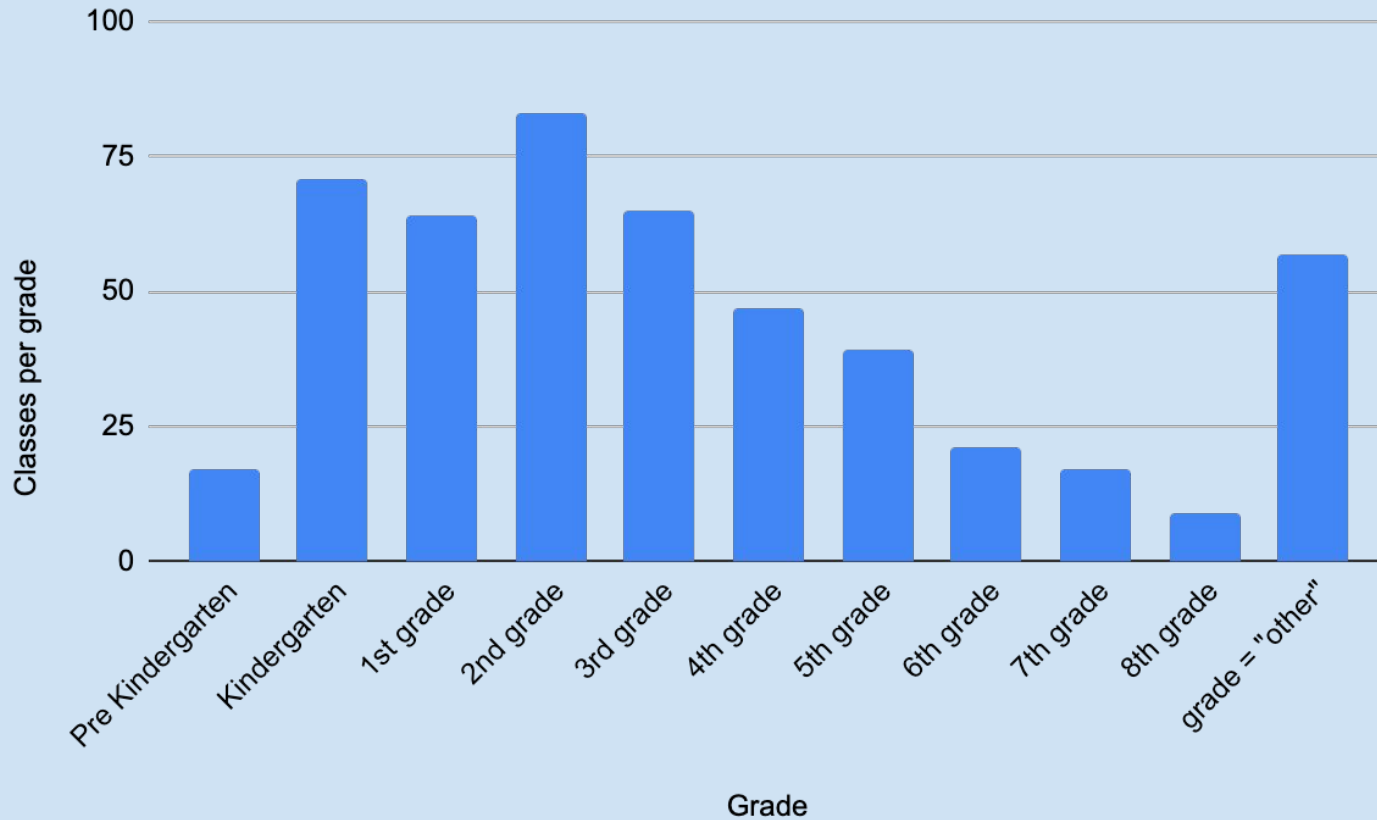

Classes Created Per Grade




Supporting English Language Development with Seesaw

Seesaw for Schools - Discounts

Seesaw for Schools typically costs \$5.50 per student, per year -- this is what you can expect if schools purchase individually.

With district implementations, the following discounts are available:

- 0-1,000 students: \$5.50 per student / year
- 1,000+ students: 5% off, resulting in \$5.23 / student / year
- 2,500+ students: 10% off, resulting in \$4.95 / student / year
- 5,000+ students: 15% off, resulting in \$4.68 / student / year
- 10,000+ students: 20% off, resulting in \$4.40 / student / year
- 20,000 students: 30% off, resulting in \$3.85 / student / year

- Additional discount available for 2 or 3 year contracts (two year paid up front; three year has a payment plan spread out over the 3 years).
