

IT WOULD COST APPROXIMATELY \$15.00 PER \$100,000 OF ANNUAL ASSESSED PROPERTY VALUE – NOT MARKET VALUE

ALL FUNDS WOULD SUPPORT REPAIRING AND IMPROVING SCHOOLS IN OUR COMMUNITY AND COULD NOT BE TAKEN BY THE STATE





### PROVISIONS OF PROPOSED RESOLUTION

- INDEPENDENT CITIZENS' OVERSIGHT AND REPORTS TO THE COMMUNITY WOULD BE REQUIRED TO ENSURE FUNDS ARE SPENT AS PROMISED
- FUNDS ARE NOT USED TO INCREASE SALARIES, BENEFITS OR PENSIONS FOR ADMINISTRATORS, TEACHERS, OR OTHER SCHOOL EMPLOYEES




## Mount Diablo USD: Issuance 2010 Election; Measure C Series F and G





Issue \$77 Million in Two Series (Current Projections)\*







<sup>\*</sup> Assumes 5% AV growth in 2019 thru 2021 and 3.5% thereafter






#### Mount Diablo USD: March 2018 Voter Survey
