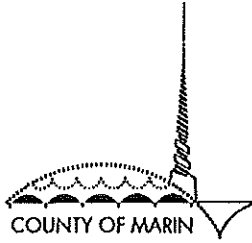

The Marin County Mental Health and Substance Use Services has certified Medi-Cal Provider #21BP, One St. Vincent's Drive, San Rafael, CA 94903, as a Short-Doyle/Medi-Cal Mental Health rehabilitation provider. The recertification will be in effect as of September 24, 2013 and will continue for three (3) years from that date. The Marin County Mental Health Plan (MMHP) will schedule a re-certification review at the end of the three (3) year period.
