RE: Removal of Surplus Equipment

The following district owned vehicles have been determined as surplus equipment that is beyond economical repair. A brief description of the repair issues has been noted.

- 1) Vehicle #319, 1977 Chevrolet C20 van, CGL36U208588
Engine problems, will not pass emission testing, body cancer, parts are not available
- 2) Vehicle #314, 1988 Dodge Aries, 1B3BD46D1JF129041
Parts are no longer available
- 3) Vehicles #306, 1988 Dodge Aries, 1B3BD46D8JF129036
Engine requires replacement, parts not available
- 4) Vehicle #307, 1990 Ford Tempo, 2FAPP36X1LB191128
Mechanical cost exceeds value of vehicle, limited part availability
- 5) V67, 1987 Ford 20 Passenger school bus, 1FDJE341BHHA94955
Parts are no longer available, engine requires replacement
- 6) V62, 1987 Ford 20 Passenger school bus, 1FDJE3415HHA94959
Body cancer questions the integrity of the vehicle.
- 7) V30, 1988 Ford 20 Passenger school bus, 1FDJE34MOJHC16482
Parts are no longer available, blown engine requiring replacement.
- 8) V43, 1995 International school bus, 1HVBBAAM9SH209522
Engine require replacement, unit has been cannibalized for parts
- 9) Bus # 33, 2001 Bluebird CNG school bus, 1BABNBMA81F096400
Engine requires replacement and is no longer available.
