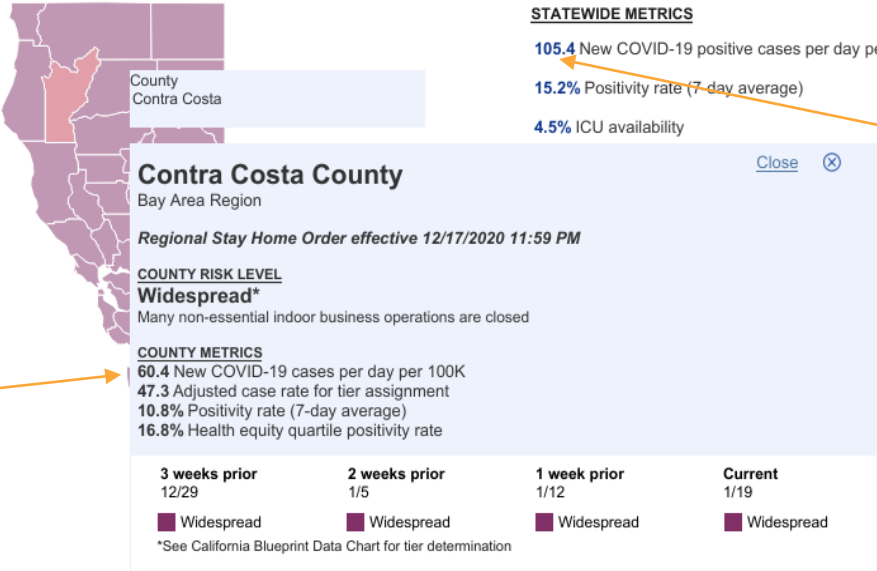

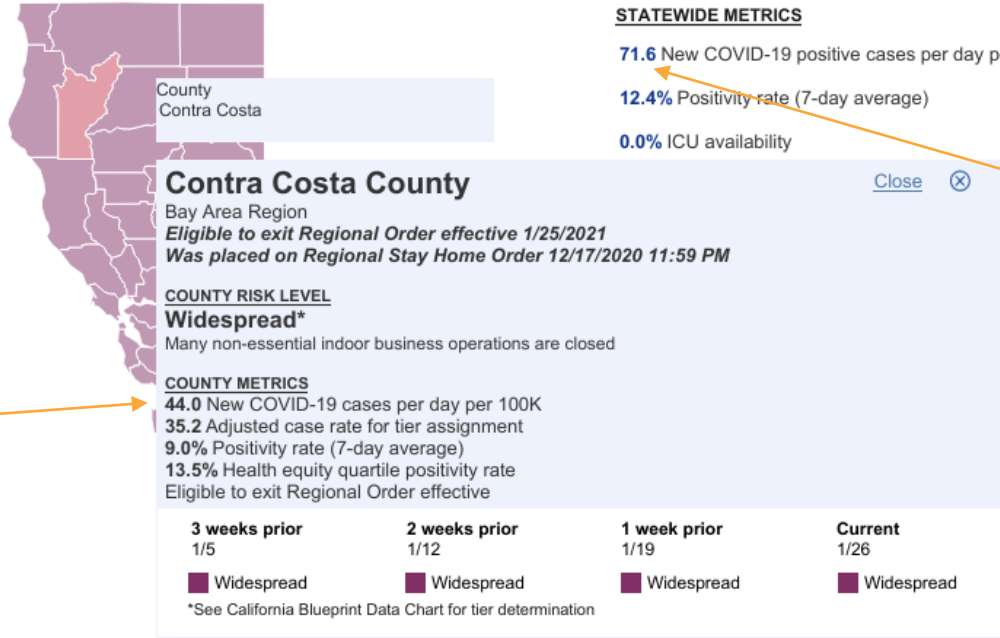

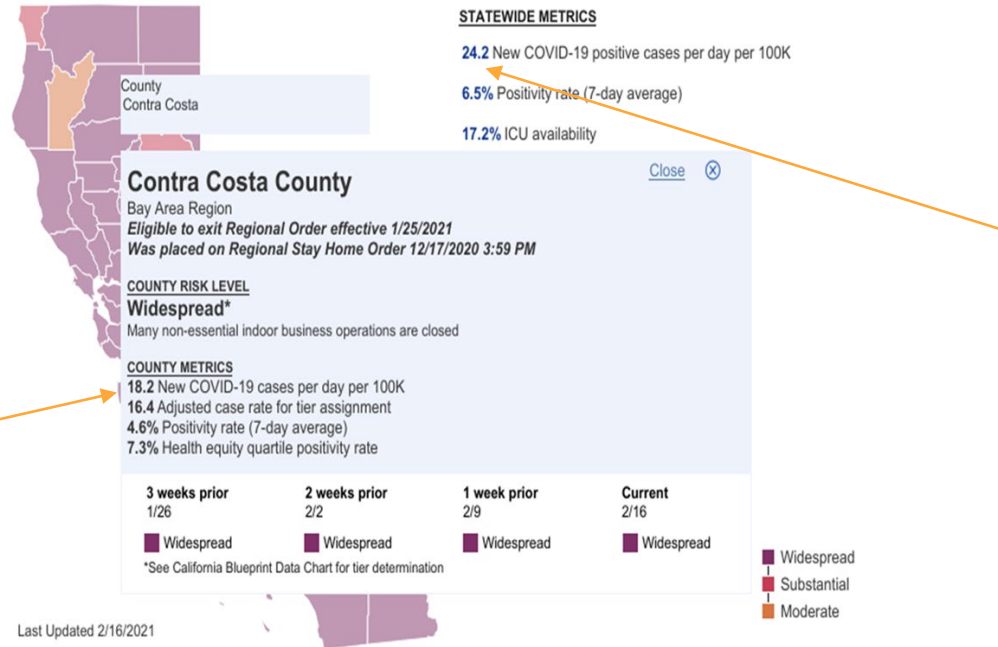

# Contra Costa County 2/16/21

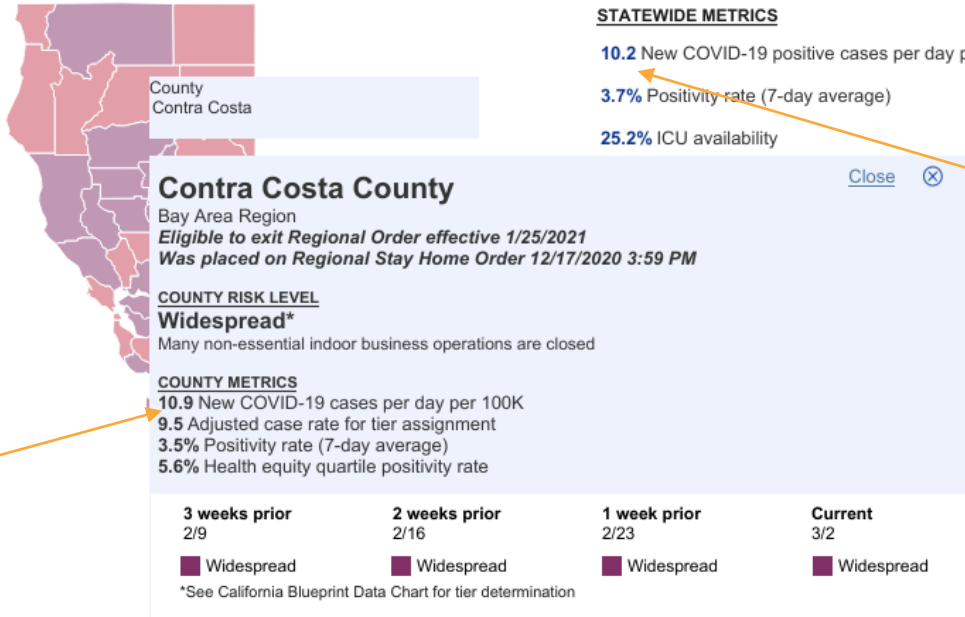

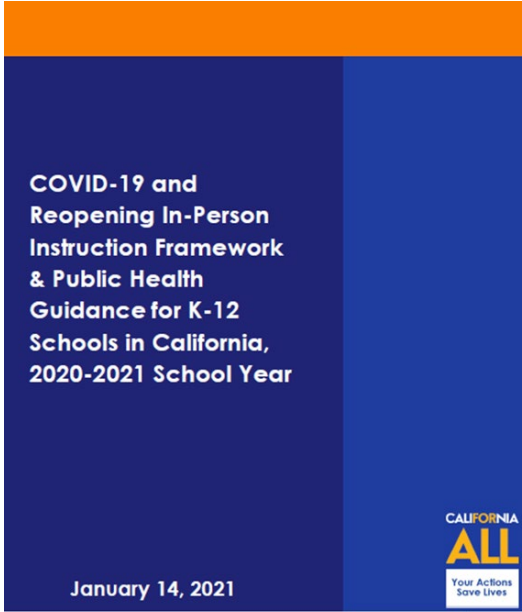
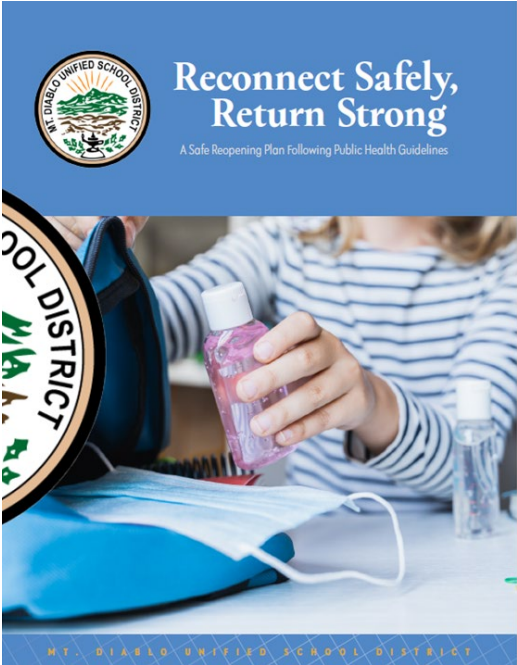
