## **Principal's Report:**

Review Bond Funds:

Dr. McAdam reviewed the 1.5 million Bond Fund list of projects for CHS that have been proposed and completed, or near completion by this summer.

- Woodshop wiring – completed
- White boards for most classrooms – ordered and will be installed during the summer
- Install LCD in classroom ceilings – process of being installed and finished this school year
- Doc cameras for all departments – in the process of being installed. The 200, 300, 500, 600 and music room have been installed. The 700, 800 and 900 hall should be finished next month.
- Re-seed football field & soccer field – the football field was re-seeded once the sprinkler system was in proper working order – soccer field will not be done at this time
- Marquee and electricity w/wireless to office – project will be completed this summer.
- Pave area next to 900 wing plus the area up to the football fence. Also, if permitting, the area by the woodshop and cafeteria will be paved this summer
- Update administration building heating/air conditioning system - work has started on the office
- Installation of additional surveillance cameras – 5 have been installed
- Re-model/clean up student bathrooms – Leadership students have taken on this project.

It is proposed with the additional 6.7 million in Bond Funds for the following projects be approved:

- Science wing – proposed construction of two new classrooms with a lab in the middle is planned
- Multi-purpose type building for PE, music, wrestling, drama, cheerleading, etc – in the planning stage

Jane Kwiatkowski motioned to approve the projects, seconded by Rebecca Jensen and approved by the Council.
